



### Intelligent Transport System installation - M4 Motorway, Homebush

Further to notification N331f, from Monday 29 October 2018, work will continue on the M4 Motorway and surrounding roads in Homebush to install Intelligent Transport System (ITS) infrastructure, Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras and road work as listed below. This work will require night closures on the M4 Motorway and the M4 Motorway on-ramp at Homebush Bay Drive. Residents will be notified as work progresses. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Testing of tolling gantries is also underway. Toll tags may beep when driving under the gantry, however, no tolls will be charged.

#### What we're doing

This work will involve:

- utilities investigation and installation (including cable pulling)
- installing ITS infrastructure, CCTV cameras and signage
- asphaltting and concreting
- installing noise wall panels, barriers and medians
- line marking
- drainage maintenance
- permanent restoration works.

Equipment used during the work will include excavators, piling rig, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, paving equipment, rollers, jack hammers, concrete trucks, asphaltting trucks, core drills, chainsaws, cranes, elevated work platform, trucks, compactors, site vehicles, small tools, hand tools and lighting equipment.

#### How this affects you

During this work, night closures of the M4 Motorway westbound and eastbound, and lane closures on the M4 Motorway on-ramp at Homebush Bay Drive will be required. Specific information regarding these closures will be communicated via comprehensive Variable Message Signs (VMS) and [livetraffic.com](http://livetraffic.com).

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery. At night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences. All sites will be restored to their previous condition.
