



VMS Installation Work - Waratah Street, Haberfield

From Thursday, 18 October 2018 work will commence to install the Variable Messaging Sign (VMS) on Waratah Street, Haberfield. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Work is expected to take up to two shifts in a week to complete, weather dependent. If work cannot be completed during this time, you will be notified.

What we're doing

Work will involve:

- lifting the VMS structure into position;
- securing the VMS structure to the footing.

Equipment used during the work will include a crane, rattle guns, lighting equipment, generators and hand tools.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Parking may be limited in the vicinity of the work site. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage.
