



## Restoration work - North Strathfield and Homebush

Further to notification (N358e) from Monday, 17 December 2018, work will continue to restore roads and footpaths in various locations in North Strathfield and Homebush.

The work is expected to take six weeks to complete, weather permitting. You will be notified as work progresses.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

### What we're doing

This work will involve:

- Asphalt and concrete pavement
- Concrete works including: footpaths, kerb and gutter, pram ramps and driveways
- Landscaping

Equipment during the work will include: nail gun, grinder, hand held saw, road saw, concrete saw, jack hammer, trucks, light vehicles and trailers, hand tools, lighting towers, generator, excavator, concrete trucks, compactor, profiler, bobcat, sweeper, drum roller and asphalt paver.

### How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

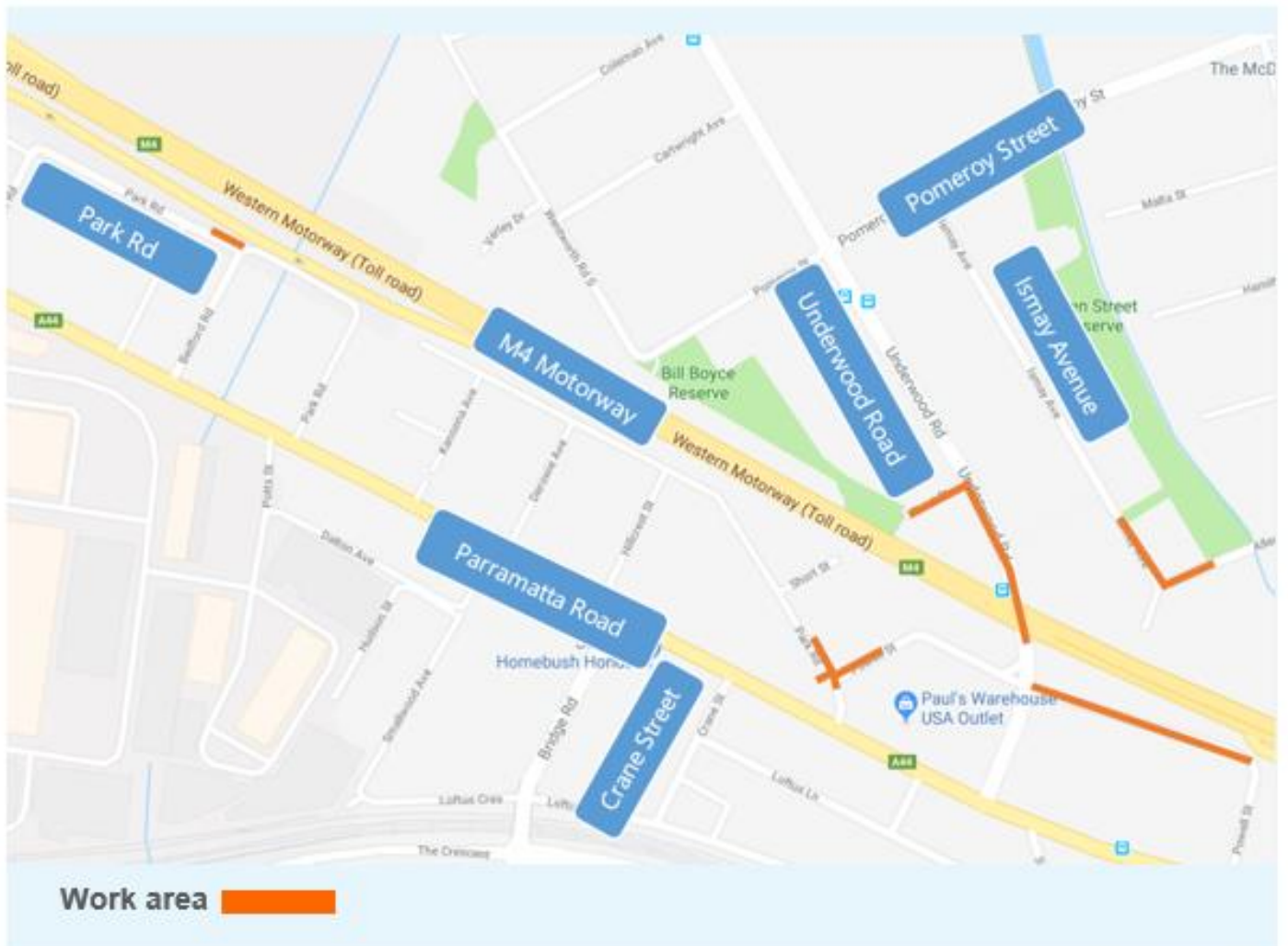
