



Restoration work - Homebush

Further to notification (N358h) from Sunday, 17 March 2019, work will continue to restore roads and footpaths in various locations in Homebush.

The work is expected to take two months to complete, weather permitting. You will be notified as work progresses.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- laying asphalt and concrete pavement
- concrete works including; footpaths, kerb & gutter, pram ramps and driveways
- landscaping
- demobilisation works including: removal of temporary noise wall, removal of temporary services

Equipment used during the work will include: nail gun, grinder, hand held saw, road saw, concrete saw, jack hammer, trucks, light vehicles and trailers, hand tools, lighting towers, generator, excavator, concrete trucks, compactor, profiler, bobcat, sweeper, drum roller, asphalt paver.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.
