



Construction work – Homebush

Further to notification (N358i) from Sunday, 17 March 2019, work will continue to restore roads and footpaths in various locations in Homebush.

The work is expected to take one month to complete, weather permitting. You will be notified as work progresses.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- Laying asphalt and concrete pavement
- Concrete works including; footpaths, kerb & gutter, pram ramps and driveways
- Landscaping and fencing
- Demobilisation works including: removal of temporary noise wall, removal of temporary services

Equipment used during the work will include: nail gun, grinder, hand held saw, road saw, concrete saw, jack hammer, trucks, light vehicles and trailers, hand tools, lighting towers, generator, excavator, concrete trucks, compactor, profiler, bobcat, sweeper, drum roller, asphalt paver, small power tools, franna crane, mobile crane, concrete pumps, elevated work platforms, trucks and excavators with hammer attachments.

How this affects you

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers. Access to driveways will be maintained.

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this by, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

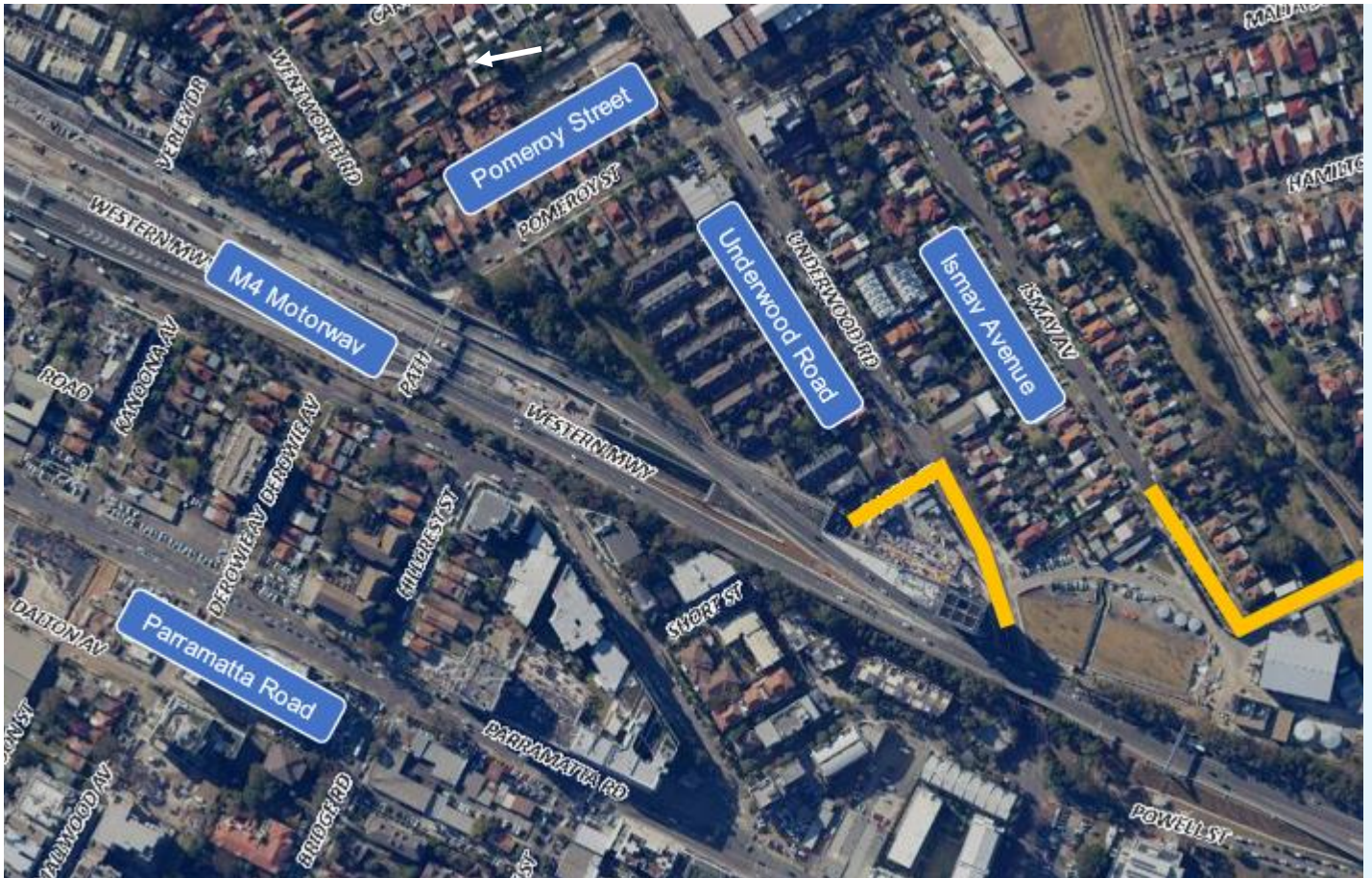
