



Road and footpath restoration - North Strathfield

From Thursday 13 December 2018, sections of Queen Lane and Carrington Street, North Strathfield will be re-asphalted to restore the road surface. Concreting work will also be completed to facilitate the construction of new footpaths, kerbs and gutters.

The work is expected to take four weeks to complete, weather depending. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- Concreting works including: footpaths, kerb and gutter, roads, etc
- Asphalt Pavement, Milling (remove top layer) and re-sheeting

Equipment used will include: sweeper, profiler, float-trailer, light vehicles, smooth drum roller, multi wheel roller, bob cat, excavator, vibrating compactor plate, concrete trucks, concrete saw and asphalt paver.

How this affects you

Whilst asphaltting works are underway, vehicle access will be restricted. Asphaltting in each section is expected to take one day to complete with residents provided 24 hours' notice prior to works commence. At the end of the day the road will re-open to vehicles.

Asphaltting works are typically loud and accompanied by a strong odour. Every effort will be made to minimise this impact including by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.

Concreting works (on either side of Carrington Street) will be undertaken consecutively and pedestrian access along the route will be maintained, with pedestrian access to properties maintained at all times. During these works Carrington Street and Queen Lane will be temporarily closed to general traffic, with access maintained to properties with traffic controllers.
