



## Changed Traffic Conditions - Wattle Street, Haberfield

On Saturday, 15 December 2018 further traffic changes at the Wattle Street and Ramsay Street intersection will occur. These traffic changes are anticipated to occur over one night, weather and ground conditions permitting. These changes are outlined below and shown on the map provided overleaf:

- removing the temporary work site between Ramsay Street and Waratah Street;
- opening the permanent, dedicated left hand turn lane into Ramsay Street from Wattle Street eastbound;
- extending the permanent, dedicated right hand turn lane into Ramsay Street from Wattle Street eastbound;
- reopening the right-hand turn from Waratah Street into City West Link.

### What we're doing

This work will involve:

- installing and relocating traffic barriers, signage, asphalt, line marking and directional markers;
- the reconfiguring of traffic signals.

Equipment will include vacuum trucks, concrete saws, line marking equipment, cranes, millers, rollers, excavators, compactor plates, trucks, hand tools and lighting equipment.

### How this affects you

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

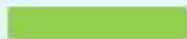
