



Wattle Street Interchange - Haberfield

In anticipation of project opening in the upcoming months, from Wednesday, 8 May 2019 work continues around the Wattle Street Interchange, Haberfield. A map showing the location of work is provided overleaf.

Updates will continue to be provided to residents monthly.

What we're doing

Remaining activities will involve:

- road work including ensuring temporary traffic controls remain in place, and line marking;
- residual footpath restoration; and,
- maintaining landscaping, utilities and environmental controls.

Equipment used will include vacuum trucks, line marking equipment, drum rollers, trucks, concrete saws, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

Some of this work is required to be undertaken outside of standard construction hours due to road occupancy requirements. Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.
