



Day/night and weekend work at the intersection of Sydney Park Road, Euston Road and Huntley Street Alexandria

We will build new road pavement as part of the upgrade to the Sydney Park Road, Euston Road and Huntley Street intersection. Set-up for this work will start from 6:30am on Friday 4 January 2019 and continue until 6am Monday 14 January (weather permitting).

Some of this work will be done at night and on weekends due to necessary lane closures and for the safety of road users and workers.

What we're doing

We will relocate and install concrete barriers, mill the existing road pavement and place new pavement and asphalt on the road surface. Please see the map overleaf which helps to explain the location of the works and related traffic changes. Construction works are scheduled at the following times:

Weekend one:

- **6:30am on Friday 4 January to 7am on Monday 7 January (inclusive)**

Day work only:

- **Monday 7 January from 7am to 6pm**
- **Tuesday 8 January from 7am to 6pm**
- **Wednesday 9 January from 7am to 6pm**
- **Thursday 10 January from 7am to 6pm**
- **Friday 11 January from 7am to 6pm**

Weekend two:

- **6pm on Friday 11 January to 5am on Monday 14 January (inclusive)**

Traffic changes

The traffic lights at the intersection of Sydney Park Road, Euston Road and Huntley Street Alexandria will be disabled from 6:30am on Friday 4 January until 5am on Monday 14 January. A stop/slow traffic control set up will be set-up 24 hours per day to manage all traffic movements through the intersection. Delays are expected, so allow plenty of extra travel time and use alternative routes where possible.

The following lane closures and traffic changes will also be in place from 6:30am on Friday 4 January until 5am on Monday 14 January, 24 hours per day:

- All eastbound lanes and one westbound lane will close on Sydney Park Road. Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times via a stop/slow setup on the remaining westbound lane, under traffic control.
- The left turn from Sydney Park Road to Euston Road and the right turn from Euston Road onto Sydney Park Road will remain available at all times under traffic control.
- One northbound lane on Euston Road will be closed north of the Sydney Park Road intersection.
- One westbound lane on Huntley Street will be closed between Burrows Road and Euston Road.
- A traffic detour will be in place for motorists travelling westbound on Huntley Street.
- No access to Euston Road (south) via Burrows Road/Huntley Street or Sydney Park Road. Detour via Bourke Road, Maddox Street and Euston Road.

Please drive with care and follow the direction of traffic control signage and personnel.

How this affects you

We will use an excavator, concrete saw cutter, roller, plate compactor, asphalt paver, line marking machine, crane, vacuum trucks, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, lighting towers and generators to complete the works. Work will include asphalt milling. Asphalt milling will create heat and may have an associated odour. This asphalt milling method is the standard construction process for removing asphalt. All New M5 Project Safety and Environmental regulations will be adhered to during this work. A water truck will be onsite to help mitigate dust.

The site compounds on Euston Road and on May Street, St Peters will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage and vehicle parking.

This work will be noisy. We will minimise noise and light spill by scheduling noisy work during the day (where possible), install noise blankets around the work areas, turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use, use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery and directing noise generating equipment and turn lights away from residents' properties where possible.
