## **Electrical work at 141-167 McEvoy Street, Alexandria**

Work to install a new 132kv electricity cable along Euston Road from the substation on Burrows Road has progressed well, and now the project team are required to connect the new conduits into an electrical bay located at 141-167 McEvoy Street. Upon completion of this work, Ausgrid will continue installing the new cable along McEvoy Street to Waterloo.

### **Scope of work**

The work includes constructing a new concrete pit in the ground for the 132kV electrical cable connection. To facilitate this, four trees within the work site have been identified to be removed because their root structures are likely to be damaged by the construction. The trees have been assessed by an arborist.

Work will take place in the verge outside the Datum apartments located at 141-167 McEvoy Street and will be contained in a fenced construction site. Please see image overleaf for the location of the work site.

### **Timing of work**

One shift of night work is required to establish the work site on **Monday 18 September** between **9pm and 6am**. This work will be conducted at night when traffic volumes are lower for the safety for workers, motorists and pedestrians.

The night work includes installing concrete barriers and signage along the road. Noise impact from the work is expected to be moderate.

Day work will commence from **Monday 18 September** for approximately six weeks, weather permitting. Work will be conducted during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

### **Site arrangement**

The construction site will be established within the verge and pedestrian path adjacent to McEvoy Street. Pedestrians will be directed to use the pathway closest to the building instead. Concrete barriers will be used to separate the work area from the pedestrian pathway and signage will be in place.

Construction vehicles will enter the site from McEvoy Street at the location of the driveway and will be assisted by traffic control.

### **Street parking impacts**

Due to the placement of concrete barriers on the road, street **parking on both sides of the street at this location will be removed** for the duration of works. The clearway and parking will be reinstated once the work is completed.

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## Minimising community impact

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of the construction activity on residents by:

- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, particularly during night work
- Scheduling work to take place early in the night where possible
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Having traffic control assist vehicles and pedestrians across around the site
- Regular updates provided to resident body to provide progress of work and obtain feedback
- Directing noise generating and light emitting equipment away from residential properties where possible.

Traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. Access to streets and properties adjoining Euston Road will be maintained.
