

## Night work on Church Avenue, Mascot

Night work will take place on Church Avenue, Mascot to investigate the location of existing utilities in preparation for their relocation and as part of the Bourke Street upgrade. This work is required to be undertaken at night under traffic management for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

## Timing and scope of works

Work will be carried out for two nights, weather permitting, on **Friday 3 November and Monday 6 November (a contingency night)** between the hours of **8pm and 5am**.

Work will take place at the **intersection of Church Avenue and Bourke Street**. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

The work will involve opening a small trench in the pavement, removing ground material, identifying the services and their depth in the ground, installing a new electrical pole and then reinstating the earth.

Equipment used during the work will include lighting towers, hand tools, vacuum truck, bucket trucks, traffic management and construction vehicles.

## Traffic changes

**A partial closure of Church Avenue will be in place during the work. Motorists will be directed to enter and exit Church Avenue from Kent Road.** A map showing the partial road closure is provided overleaf. Access to driveways located on Church Avenue, and the Woolworths carpark will always remain available throughout the work.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes.

## Minimising impact on residents

The work is expected to create medium noise levels to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

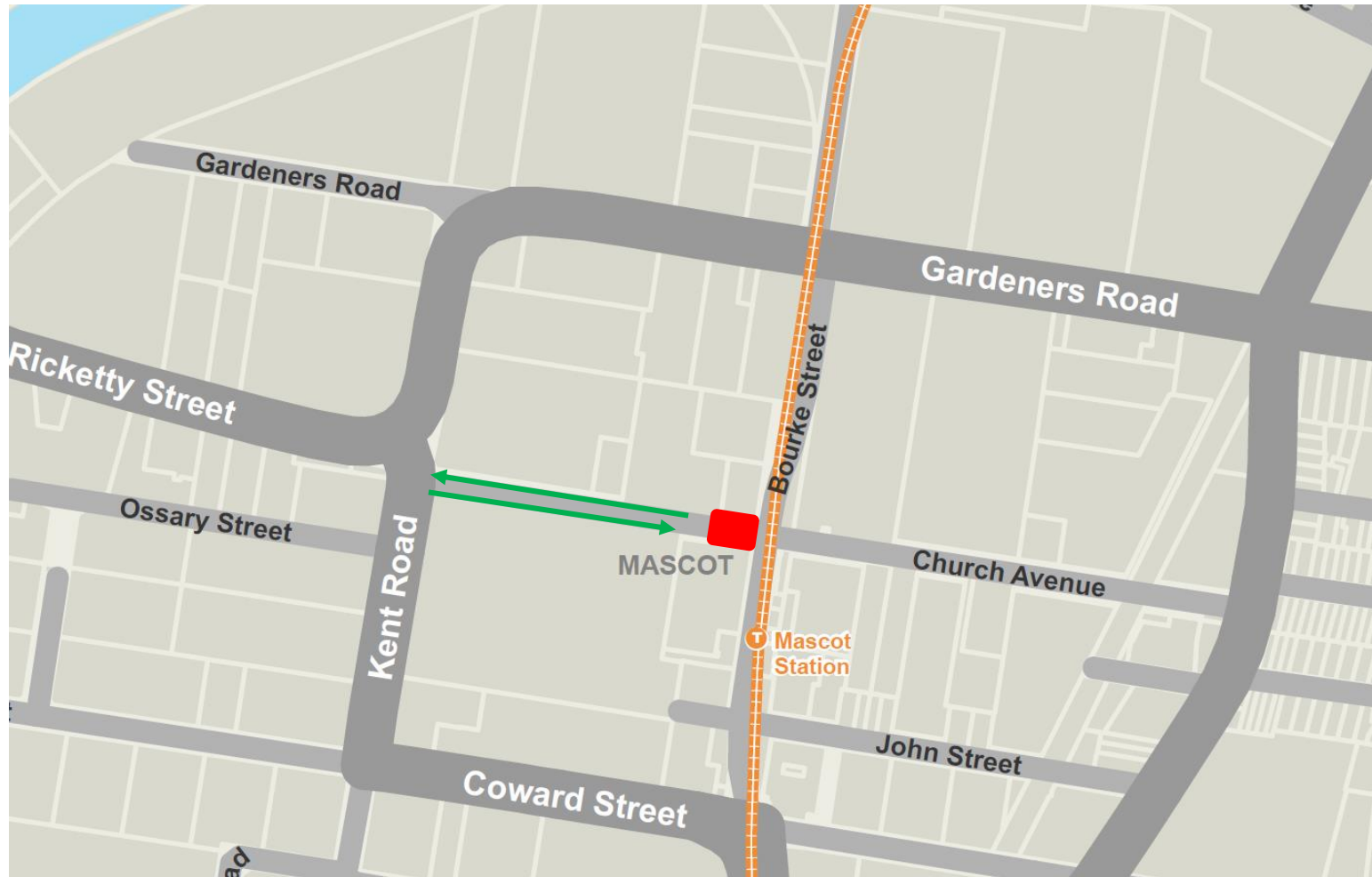
