

Upcoming night work – Campbell Road, St Peters

Night work will be carried out around Campbell Road, St Peters, for the delivery and unloading of concrete girders onto the New M5 construction site. We will do this work at night to minimise traffic impacts to your neighbourhood during the day, and to ensure the safety of road users and our workers. A map showing the location is provided overleaf.

Work will start from **Wednesday 1 November** and is expected to take up to 4 nights per week over **4 weeks**, weather permitting. Work hours are between **midnight and 7am from Wednesdays to Saturdays**. No work will be carried out on Sundays or public holidays.

Work activities

This work involves one truck per night shift delivering and unloading concrete girders onto the New M5 construction site next to Campbell Road.

Minimising community impact

There may be some impacts to residents during this work, including vehicle noise and lighting. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by working no more than four nights in a week and no more than three nights in a row.

Temporary traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the delivery is safe including a police escort to the work site. Access to properties will be maintained.
