

## Night work in Kingsgrove

Work is progressing to extend the M5 motorway in Kingsgrove from Kirrang Street North towards Garema Circuit. We are currently constructing the new eastbound carriageway north of the existing M5 motorway. The next stage involves applying a concrete pavement layer to form part of the road surface. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Due to high traffic volumes on the M5 motorway and to ensure safe operations, this work will be carried out during night shifts from **Saturday 13 January intermittently until late February 2018** (weather permitting). The work hours will be from **Monday to Sunday between 6.00 pm and 5.00 am**.

The work will include:

- Delivery of concrete and materials
- Pouring concrete along the new road alignment
- Paving the surface layer.

Other works will be undertaken during the existing M5 East maintenance shutdown period in sections of the road verge between Kingsgrove Road and King Georges Road to progress construction in Kingsgrove. Due to the high traffic volumes on the M5 East and for the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, this work will be carried out over four nights from **Sunday 14 January 2018** (weather permitting). The work will be undertaken between **6.00 pm and 5.00 am**.

The work will include:

- Repositioning existing concrete safety barriers from the road verge and adding new barriers
- New line markings to set up lanes for site access
- Installing signage and bollards near site access gates
- Road sweeping
- Excavating east and westbound cut and cover structures

## Construction Impacts

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise monitoring will be conducted for all work undertaken outside of standard construction hours. Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through these changed traffic conditions.

We will use excavators, concrete trucks, a boom pump, road sweepers, concrete cutters, lighting towers, generators, hand drills, a paver machine as well as construction vehicles.

This work is part of the New M5 project which will duplicate the existing M5 tunnel and double traffic capacity of the M5 East corridor. For more information, visit [westconnex.com.au/NewM5](http://westconnex.com.au/NewM5).
