

Night work on May Street St Peters

Night work will be undertaken to remove concrete barriers currently located on the southbound lane of May Street, near Campbell Street.

The concrete barriers will later be reinstated, and the current footpath will be removed for drainage and utility installation and upgrade work. You will be notified in advance of the concrete barriers being reinstated in this area.

A new pavement and footpath will be built after the drainage and utilities have been installed in mid-2018.

Timing and work hours

Night work will take place on **Monday 12 February** from **7pm to 5am**.

Traffic changes

- Two-way traffic will be maintained on May Street during night work with stop / slow traffic in place.
- Traffic control will also be in place on Unwins Bridge Road, Bedwin Road and Campbell Street around the intersection. Traffic in both directions will be maintained.

This work will be conducted at night when traffic volumes are lower for the safety for workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. Please allow for delays while this night work is being carried out.

Impacts of work

Pedestrian and cyclist footpath access will be maintained along May Street. At times, during work hours, pedestrians and cyclists may be detoured under direction from traffic control personnel across May Street away from the work areas.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

On-street parking will be temporarily reinstated in the area as shown on the map overleaf.

Equipment used

Equipment used during night work will include a mobile crane, truck, light vehicles, lighting tower, and hand tools.

Minimising community impact

The work is expected to create some noise impacts to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery during night work
- directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

Traffic control will be in place to manage road users through the changes.
