



Work in your area - Bexley North

Work in your area will be undertaken for two weeks from the week beginning 2 April 2018

What we're doing

Barrier removal and placement work

Night work will be carried out to remove concrete barriers from outside of the Bexley Site spoil shed located on the western side of Bexley Road. An alternate style of concrete barriers will also be installed in a new alignment to enable the next phase of the project to commence at this site.

Overhead pedestrian footbridge

During the day work will continue; however the next phase of the project involves the closure of the overhead pedestrian bridge located on Bexley Road between Kingsgrove Avenue and the M5 East on ramp.

The overhead pedestrian bridge on Bexley road will closed for approximately 17 months from April 2018 to September 2019 to enable the construction of motorway facilities and the a new access ramp to the bridge. A map showing the pedestrian detour is provided overleaf.

How this affects you

Barrier removal and placement work

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise modelling has been conducted for all work undertaken outside of standard construction hours. These works will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and road users through these changed traffic conditions.

Overhead pedestrian footbridge

Diversion/detour signs will be erected to direct pedestrians to a signalled pedestrian crossing.
