



Night work crane delivery and demobilisation of spoil shed, Bexley North

What we're doing

Crane components will be delivered to the Bexley North tunnel shed between 2am and 5am on 19 April 2018.

A lane will be closed to northbound traffic, and the Westbound entry to the M5 east via Bexley Road during work.

Work to dismantle the spoil shed on the western side of Bexley Road will start from 19 April 2018 and will take four weeks to complete (weather pending).

How this affects you

During the crane delivery an exclusion zone will be established to ensure pedestrian and traffic safety. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and road users through these changed traffic conditions

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise modelling has been conducted for work undertaken outside of standard construction hours.

Some work will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.
