



## Work in your area - Bexley North

Work in your area will be undertaken from the week beginning 30 April to 11 May 2018.

### What we're doing

#### Crane delivery

A crane will be delivered to the motorway compound via the driveway on Bexley Road, Earlwood to enable the installation of additional crib rooms to our Bexley Site Office on Wolli Avenue, Bexley North.

A second crane will be delivered to the compound on the western side of Bexley Road, Earlwood to assist with the demobilisation of the sheds currently being disassembled.

#### Installation of Portable Buildings

Four 6x3 metre portable buildings will be delivered on oversized trucks after midnight and installed via crane into the Bexley Site Office on Wolli Avenue, Bexley North.

#### Survey Establishment

A number of survey points will be installed to assist construction of the new Motorway Operation Complex.

#### Potholing

Work to locate utilities is required in preparation for the construction of the new Motorway Operation Complex. This will involve noise producing works on the shoulder of Bexley Road and the current driveway to site.

#### How this affects you

Lane closures will occur on the south and north sides of Bexley Road, Bexley North.

During the crane delivery an exclusion zone will be established and pedestrian detours will be in place while work takes place to ensure pedestrian and traffic safety.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and road users through these changed traffic conditions.

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise modelling has been conducted. Work will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists.

Diversion/detour signs to be erected to direct pedestrians to a signalled pedestrian crossing.

During these works we may use excavators, lighting towers, electric jackhammer, concrete cutters, road sweeper, vacuum truck, generators, cranes, oxy cutters, concrete agitator, hand drills, compressors and pumps as well as construction vehicles.




Noisy work will be undertaken early in the night, and before 12am where possible. Noise producing work will not take place for more than 3 consecutive nights.
