



Night work along Marsh Street, Arncliffe

Night work is required to facilitate the installation of banners along the outside of the Marsh Street compound at Arncliffe. To minimise the impact on peak hour traffic the work is required to be undertaken at night. A lane closure will also be required (see map overleaf).

What we're doing

The NewM5 team will be installing banners along the outside of the Marsh Street compound. These works will include each night:

- Setting up of the temporary lane closure to facilitate this work
- Placement of the elevated work platform onto the shared path
- Installation of banners (approximately 2-3 banners per night) from east to west (airport towards Arncliffe)
- Securement of banners installed at the end of each shift
- Removal of plant at the end of each shift back into the compound.

Equipment to be used generator for task lighting, elevated work platform (EWP), hand tools and battery operated drills/tools and construction vehicles.

Traffic Changes

During this work there will be a one lane closure along the westbound lane on Marsh Street. This will only be in place during the working hours. Traffic control will be in place to assist any pedestrians or cyclists that may use the pathway.

How this affects you

There should be little impact to residents during this work. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by facing the lighting away from any residential properties
