



Night work and night traffic changes on Barwon Park Road, Crown Street and Campbell Street, St Peters and Campbell Road, Alexandria on Tuesday 26 June, Wednesday 27 June and Thursday 28 June.

Night work will take place to prepare for permanent and temporary traffic changes from 5am Friday 29 June, details of these traffic changes are outlined in notification no.436.

Night work will also take place on Thursday 28 June from 9pm to 1am on Campbell Street between Princes Highway and Crown Street to carry out disinfection of the newly installed Sydney Water pipes in this area.

What we're doing

Night time asphaltting of the Campbell Road/Street road surface, line marking removal, new line marking, fence and concrete barrier relocation in preparation for the changed traffic conditions to be put in place from 5am on Friday 29 June.

Night work:

- Tuesday 26 June, 7pm to 6am
- Wednesday 27 June, 7pm to 6am
- Thursday 28 June, 7pm to 6am

Traffic changes during the 3 night work shifts

- Two way traffic permitted on Crown Street under traffic control.
- No access from Crown Street or Barwon Park Road to Campbell Street/Road.
- Exit for Euston Road businesses will be permitted via Burrows Road or Barwon Park Road.
- No access from Campbell Street (west) to Campbell Street (east).

Traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the temporary traffic changes.

Pedestrian access will be maintained through Campbell Street/Road.

How this affects you

We will use mobile cranes, asphalt paver, roller, vac truck, plate compactor, line marking removal trucks, line marking trucks, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, compaction equipment and lighting towers to complete this work.

Our site compounds on southern side of Campbell Street/Road will be used intermittently throughout the work to store materials and park vehicles.

This work is expected to generate noise however every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with this work by installing noise blankets around the work site, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

Residents identified by noise assessment as being eligible for alternative accommodation during these night work shifts will be contacted directly by a member of the New M5 Community Relations Team.
