



Noise wall removal at Marsh Street Compound, Arncliffe

Night work including a lane closure is needed to facilitate the removal of the first half of the container noise wall at the Marsh Street compound Arncliffe. This work will be undertaken over three nights over a two-week period. A contingency of an extra week may be required to complete these works (weather permitting).

What we're doing

The first half of the container noise wall located along Marsh Street Arncliffe will be removed. We will use an Elevated Work Platform (EWP) along the inside of the Marsh Street site to access and unfix the containers. A crane will be brought in and positioned in the Marsh Street compound to lift containers onto the back of a waiting truck and driven away.

Equipment to be used include a tower crane, elevated work platform, lighting towers and trucks to complete these works.

Commencing early next week, during standard construction hours, a tower crane will also be assembled onsite to construct the building structure over the exhaust shaft.

Once the first half of the noise wall is removed, work activities in the exhaust shaft will continue during standard construction hours.

How this affects you

There may be some impacts to residents during this work, including noisy machinery and the use of lighting. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by not idling plant and equipment when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, and facing lighting towers away from any residential properties.

A left lane closure will be in place and trucks (up to approximately four at a time) will be lined up along Marsh Street (see map overleaf). Traffic control will be in place during this closure.
