



Night work on Euston Road, Alexandria - Asphaltting work

Work has been undertaken to construct the first half of a new drain underneath Euston Road **south of Sydney Park roundabout**. Crews are required to switch traffic to the other side of the road in this area, so that the second stage of drain construction can commence. This notification refers to asphaltting work required to be undertaken at night, when traffic volumes are lowest for the safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians.

What we're doing

Work will be undertaken on **Wednesday 4 July and Thursday 5 July (contingency night)** to lay new asphalt in the section around Munni Creek drain ready for use by traffic once work is completed.

This work will involve a large machine progressively laying asphalt to the finished road level. Multiple deliveries of material via Sydney Park Road and the roundabout will be required throughout the night to facilitate the work.

Work will be undertaken between **6pm and 6am each night**, weather permitting. This work is required to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are lowest for the safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians.

A map showing the location of work is provided overleaf.

Traffic changes

All work will be undertaken along the western most side of the road. **A stop/ slow traffic arrangement will be in place on Euston Road south of the roundabout.** Pedestrian access will be maintained for the duration of the work.

Motorists will notice a slight deviation to their usual route on Euston Road south of the roundabout, as they are shifted onto the new traffic lanes from **Thursday 5 July**.

Traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate around the closure.


Minimising impact on residents

The work is expected to create minimal noise for nearby residents. Every effort will be made to further minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Installing noise blankets around the work site
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

Equipment used will include an asphalt paver, roller, construction trucks, lighting towers, hand tools, light vehicles and traffic control.
