Ausgrid night work is scheduled to take place on Campbell Road between Euston Road and Burrows Road on Friday 10 August.

The New M5 Project will be relocating concrete barriers and implementing changed traffic conditions in connection with this night work shift.

What we're doing

Friday 10 August, 7pm to 5am

We will be relocating concrete barriers and implementing a lane closure to facilitate Ausgrid work on their asset within the site compound on Campbell Road between Euston Road and Burrows Road.

Equipment used will include a road saw, vac truck, cranes, construction vehicles and traffic management.

Traffic Changes

- Campbell Road westbound lane closure between Burrows Road and Euston Road.

Traffic control will be in place to direct local traffic. Campbell Road residents are asked to enter via Euston Road.

There may be some impact to residents during this work including noise. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use.
