



## Construction work is required for the Permanent Variable Message Sign on Princes Highway at Cooks River, Tempe

A permanent electronic variable message sign (VMS) will be installed within the road reserve on the Princes Highway, adjacent to Kendrick Park, Tempe and will commence from 11 October 2018 until end of November 2018 (weather permitting).

The location of the VMS has been selected to:

- minimise impacts to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents, bad weather, unplanned traffic incidents and other unforeseen traffic conditions, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journeys.

### What we're doing

Construction will include:

- Site set-up, including the removal of one tree,
- Barriers and fencing placed around work site
- Levelling of reserve verge
- Trenching to install power and communications services
- Footing installation including concrete pour
- Site reinstatement - reinstate verge, remove barriers and some of the fencing
- VMS sign installation - erecting of VMS pole and outreach arm

Some of the construction work will be required to be undertaken outside of standard construction hours for the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists. A map showing the location of the work area and VMS location is provided overleaf.

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, saw cutter, compactor, hand tools, drill rig, trucks and construction vehicles.
