



Rescheduled work: Night work and road closure on Bourke Street, Mascot

As part of the upgrade of Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/Street, night work is required for pavement construction and associated work such as line marking and concrete barrier installation and relocation.

Night work shifts originally scheduled for Wednesday 3 October, Thursday 4 October and Friday 5 October, as per notification N510, have been rescheduled due to adverse weather conditions.

This work will now take place during night work shifts on Wednesday 3 October, Thursday 4 October and Friday 5 October.

Due to the necessary road closures, this work will be carried out at night and over the weekend for the safety of road users and workers.

What we're doing

Bourke Street is being widened between Gardeners Road and Church Avenue. Work is being carried out in stages to build the new road pavement in this area.

Night work

Night work will be carried out to relocate concrete barriers and paint new line marking on the road surface

- **Thursday 11 October, 9pm to 5am**
- **Friday 12 October, 9pm to 5am**

Please note, all work is weather permitting.

Traffic changes

A full road closure will be in place on Bourke Street between Gardeners Road and Church Avenue. This road closure will be in place for the duration of each night work shift and during the weekend work.

Traffic controllers will be in place around the work area and on surrounding streets to direct pedestrians and motorists.

Please note changes to bus service 418 Burwood to Bondi Junction. The stop on Gardeners Road between Bourke Street and O'Riordan Street will be closed during this work.

How this affects you

Equipment used during the weekday night work will include lighting towers, line marking machines, a crane, traffic management and construction vehicles.

The work is expected to produce some low noise impacts to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may have noise impacts, to take place early in the night where possible. We will be installing noise blankets around the work areas, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery and directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.
