



Girder Installation, Canal Road St Peters

Night work is required for mobilisation of a crane along with the delivery and installation of concrete girders within the St Peters Interchange construction site near Canal Road and Princes Highway.

This work will be undertaken at night due to the size of the girders and travel restrictions for over-size loads.

What we're doing

The crane will be mobilised at the St Peters Intersection on Saturday 20 October and Sunday 21 October from 6am to 6pm.

The delivery and installation of the girders (four per night) will take place from 22 October to the 26 October 2018 6pm to 6am (weather permitting).

This work involves delivering the girders on trucks via the Princes Highway, Canal and Burrows Roads into the St Peters Interchange construction site.

We will then unload and install the girders within the St Peters Interchange construction site as in the work area shown in the map on the next page. Equipment used during the work will include mobile crane, booms, truck, lighting towers, construction vehicles.

A Traffic management escort vehicle will be in place to assist with the delivery of the girders.

How this affects you

There will be some impacts to residents during the nightwork, including noisy machinery and the use of lighting.

We will make every effort to minimise these impacts to the surrounding properties.

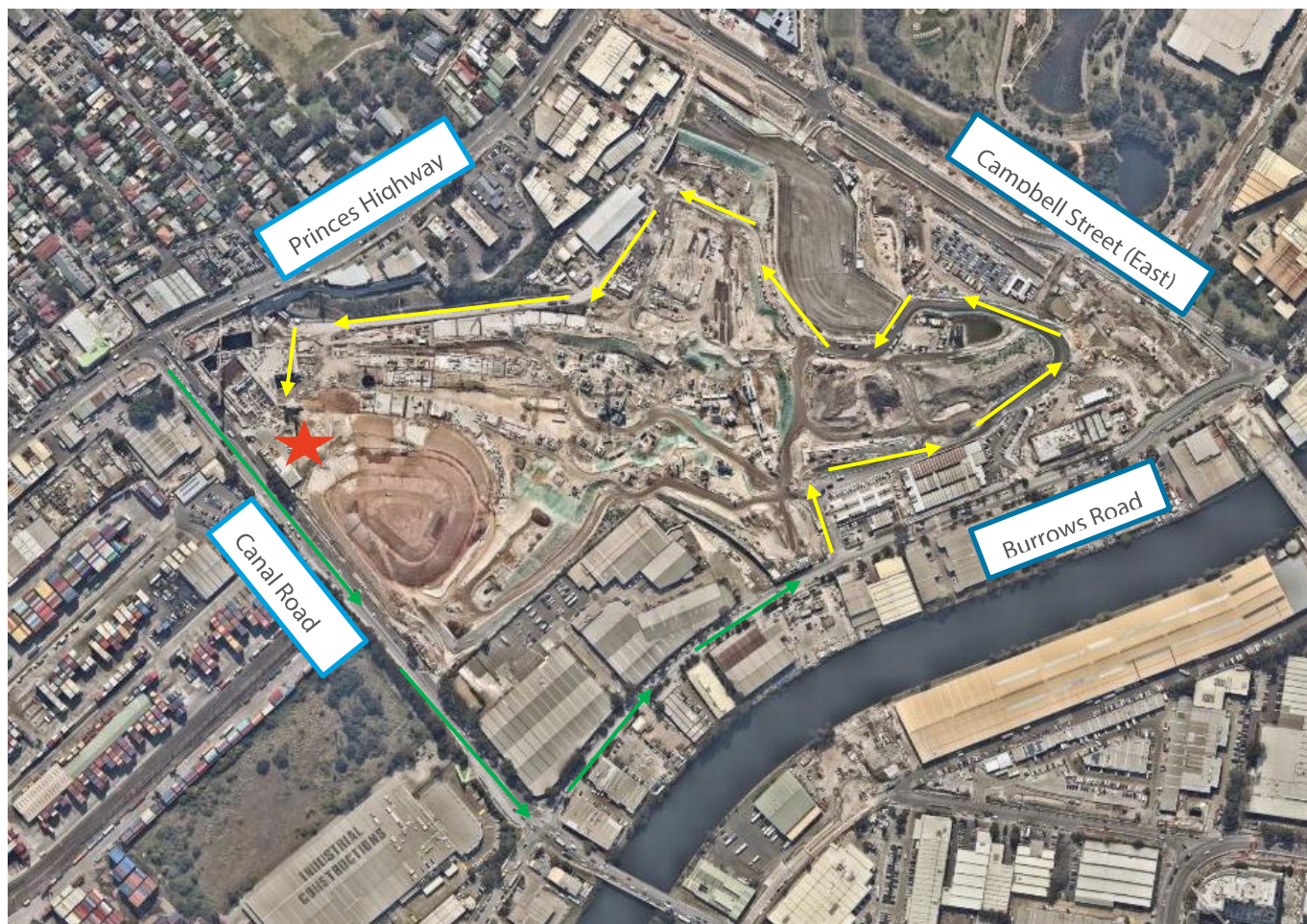
