



Preparatory works to install a toll gantry near Arinya Street Kingsgrove

Preparations are underway to install a new toll gantry near Arinya Street from Friday 2 November 2018 to 30 November 2018 (weather permitting).

What we're doing

We will dig trenches along the M5 East noise wall to install electrical conduits and prepare for piling works for the gantry footings. This work will also include tree trimmings and shrub removal next to the motorway. A licenced arborist was engaged in the planning process and will be on-site during these works.

We will use an elevated work platform, chainsaws, hand tools, construction vehicles, woodchipper and excavation machinery to complete these works.

How this affects you

Some of these works will be noisy and we will make every effort to minimise impacts to surrounding properties. These works will be carried out during standard construction hours.

An exclusion zone will be set-up for these works to ensure pedestrian and traffic safety. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians through these changed conditions. The work area will change during these works.
