



Toll gantry work on M5 East in Kingsgrove and Beverly Hills

King Georges Road intersection

The gantries have now been installed at King Georges Road and moving forward we will be completing cladding installation, alignment of the gantries, construction of footpath and installation of services. This work will take place at the off and on ramps as well as the main carriage way on the M5 East at King Georges Road Beverly Hills.

Kingsgrove Road off and on ramps

Work in preparation for the tolling gantry near the on and off ramp and main carriageway at Kingsgrove Road will continue with excavation, reinforcement and concrete works for the tolling gantry footings.

How this affects you

King Georges Road intersection

Lane closures may be established on both the on and off ramps and the main carriageway at King Georges Road during this work to ensure the safety of our workers and allow equipment access.

Kingsgrove Road off and on ramps

Closures of the lane closest to the median on the M5 East main carriageway will be in place while work is completed in this area. The off and on ramp access will remain unchanged to traffic.

Signage will be in place to assist drivers through these changed conditions. At the completion of the evenings work each the lane closure will reopen to allow traffic flow. Some of this work will be noisy. Noise modelling has been conducted for work.

The equipment used will be: Excavator, construction vehicles, piling rig, cranes, concrete pump, concrete truck, vacuum truck, hand tools, concrete cutter, generator lighting, elevated work platforms, lighting towers, impact drill, hand tools and a plate compactor.
