



Day/night work and traffic changes to open the new road and footpath along the southern side of Campbell Street from Crown Street, across Princes Highway, to Brown Street in St Peters

Current road closures on Church Street and Florence Street will also be re-opened. During this work, the fenced work areas currently located along the southern side of Campbell Street will be moved to the northern side.

What we're doing

The new road and footpath on the southern side of Campbell Street is scheduled to open to traffic by 12pm on Saturday 24 November. Three day work shifts on Thursday, Friday and Saturday and one night work shift on Friday are required.

Preparation work - Campbell Street (east) only:

- **Thursday 22 November from 10am to 3pm**
- **Friday 23 November from 7am to 7pm**

Road opening work - Campbell Street from Barwon Park Road to May Street intersection

- **7pm Friday 23 November to 12pm Saturday 24 November**

Work will involve moving concrete barriers and fencing, removing existing line marking, completing new line marking, relocating traffic lights, installing light poles and installing new signage. Some temporary lighting towers will be installed to light up the new road surface and footpath at night until the remaining new light poles are connected later this month.

New road alignment from 12pm on Saturday 24 November

Following this work, motorists will travel on the new Campbell Street road pavement, and Church Street and Florence Street will re-open at the intersection of Campbell Street.

The fenced construction work areas will be located along the northern side of Campbell Street from Crown Street, across Princes Highway, to Hutchinson Street to construct the new road and shared cycle/pedestrian path on the northern side. A business access slip lane will provide access to the Campbell Street businesses on the northern side.

We thank you for your patience during recent work on Campbell Street. There is some remaining work on the southern side of Campbell Street and surrounding streets such as road surface finishing work and line

marking at the future Campbell Street car park on the southern side of Campbell Street between Florence Street and St Peters Street, tie-in work and final landscaping work to take place before Project completion in 2020. The new Campbell Street car park will remain closed at this time.

Campbell Street (east) traffic changes on Thursday 22 November from 10am to 3pm

- Road closure between Crown St and Barwon Pk Rd; no access into Campbell St (east) from Campbell St (west)
- Right turn from Crown Street on to Campbell Street maintained

Campbell Street (east) traffic changes from 7am on Friday 23 November to 12pm on Saturday 24 November

- Road closure on Campbell Street (east) between Princes Highway and Barwon Park Road
- Road closure on Crown Street at the intersection of Campbell Street; two-way traffic permitted on Crown Street under the direction of traffic control, access to Crown Street via Barwon Park Road only

Full Campbell Street traffic changes from 7pm on Friday 23 November to 12pm on Saturday 24 November

- Road closure on Campbell Street (west) between the May Street intersection and Hutchinson Street
- Local access: St Peters St residents and Campbell Street (west) businesses via Hutchinson St into Campbell St; left turn only from St Peters St on to Campbell St
- One-way southbound traffic permitted on Hutchinson Street between Applebee Street and Lackey Street, and two-way traffic permitted on Hutchinson Street between Lackey Street and Campbell Street under the direction of traffic control
- Access to Hutchinson Street and Lackey Street via Applebee Street from May Street or Short Street
- Two-way traffic permitted on Applebee Street between May St and Hutchinson St under the direction of traffic control
- Road closure on Brown Street at the intersection of Campbell Street; access to Brown Street via Conway Place only. Parking restrictions will be in place on Brown Street prior to and for the duration of the work
- Lane closures will be in place on Princes Highway. Two-way traffic will be maintained
- Pedestrian access maintained on all local streets under the direction of traffic control

Due to the necessary safety and traffic approvals required some of this work must take place at night or over the weekend outside of peak volume times.

How this affects you

Equipment used during this work will include cranes, line marking equipment, line marking removal equipment, hand tools, construction trucks, light vehicles, light towers and traffic control. This work is expected to generate intrusive noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise and light generating equipment away from residential properties where possible. The site compounds on May street and along the southern side of Campbell Street will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage of materials and vehicle parking.
