



## Construction work is required for the Permanent Variable Message Sign on Princes Highway at Cooks River, Tempe

Construction work for the permanent electronic variable message sign (VMS) will occur on Tuesday 18 to Thursday 20 December 2018 (weather permitting).

The location of the VMS has been selected to:

- minimise impact to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents and unplanned traffic incidents, bad weather, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journeys.

### What we're doing

Construction will include:

- Site set-up including barriers and fencing placed around work site
- Levelling of reserve verge
- Footing installation including concrete pour
- Piling work

We will be working in the area again in early 2019 to complete the VMS. You will be notified prior to the work taking place.

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, saw cutter, compactor, hand tools, drill rig, trucks, lighting tower and construction vehicles to complete the works.
