



## Day/night and weekend work on Sydney Park Road and Euston Road Alexandria

Day/night and weekend work is required to upgrade road pavement and facilitate the removal of Ausgrid infrastructure. Lane closures along Euston Road and Sydney Park Road will come into effect from 10:30am on Friday 14 December and continue over the weekend.

### What we're doing

Work will take place intermittently between 10am Friday 14 December and 6pm Saturday 15 December, and on Sunday 16 December between 8am and 6pm (weather permitting). A map explaining the work locations and associated lane closures is shown overleaf.

### Euston Road utility works

- **From 10am on Friday 14 December to 6am on Saturday 15 December**  
Day and night work will be undertaken on Euston Road to locate and remove redundant Ausgrid cabling. Work in this location will include traffic management set up, relocation of concrete safety barriers, locating Ausgrid cabling, excavation and removal of cabling, and reinstatement of the work area. During this work, a detour will be in place for motorists travelling from Sydney Park Road eastbound to Euston Road northbound via Huntley Street eastbound, Bourke Road northbound, Maddox Street westbound to Euston Road. This detour is marked on the map overleaf.

### Sydney Park Road upgrade works

- **Friday 14 December, 10am to 6pm**  
Work will be undertaken to remove the current road pavement. This will involve extensive concrete breaking and excavation. During this work, asphalt milling will take place. Asphalt milling will create heat and may have an associated odour. This asphalt milling method is the standard construction process for removing asphalt. All New M5 Project Safety and Environmental regulations will be adhered to during this work. A water truck will be onsite to help mitigate dust.
- **Saturday 15 December, 8am to 6pm**  
Work will be undertaken to place new concrete. Once placed, the new concrete will be left to cure overnight. No work will occur in this location during this time, however traffic changes will remain in place.

- **Sunday 16 December, 8am to 6pm**

Once the concrete has cured, work will be undertaken to place asphalt on top of the new concrete. You may experience some vibration associated with the asphalt paving. Upon completion of the work, traffic management will be removed and normal traffic setup will resume through the intersection.

### How this affects you

#### Traffic changes:

- From **10:30am on Friday 14 December to 6am on Saturday 15 December (inclusive)** lane closures will be in place on the eastbound lane of Sydney Park Road and the northbound lane of Euston Road, north of the intersection. A traffic detour will be in place for motorists travelling from Sydney Park Road eastbound to Euston Road northbound via Huntley Street eastbound, Bourke Road northbound, Maddox Street westbound to Euston Road. This detour is marked on the map below.
- From **6am on Saturday 15 December to 6pm on Sunday 16 December**, a lane closure will be in place on one eastbound lane of Sydney Park Road and the northbound lane of Euston Road, north of the intersection will remain closed. However, two way access through the intersection of Sydney Park Road and Euston Road will be maintained by traffic control. Traffic controllers will be in place around the work area to direct motorists through the intersection. Please expect delays during this work.

Equipment used during the night/weekend work will include excavators, concrete saw cutter, roller, plate compactor, agitators, concrete paver, asphalt paver, line marking machine, crane, vacuum trucks, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, lighting towers and generators. Some work is expected to create noise, vibration and odour impacts to nearby residents.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill during the night work on Friday 14 December. We will schedule noisy work to take place early in the night where possible, install noise blankets around the work areas, turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use, use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery and direct noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

## Night/weekend work and traffic changes on Sydney Park Road and Euston Road, Alexandria between 10:30am Friday 14 December and 6pm Sunday 16 December
