



Construction work is required for the Permanent Variable Message Sign on Botany Road, Rosebery

Construction work for the permanent Variable Message Sign (VMS) is scheduled for Monday 17 December to Tuesday 18 December 2018 (weather permitting).

The location of the VMS on Botany Road between Harcourt Parade and Gardeners Road, Rosebery has been selected to:

- minimise impacts to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents, bad weather, unforeseen traffic conditions, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journey.

What we're doing

Construction will include:

- Site establishment including barriers and fencing around the work site
- Piling work
- Concrete pour for footing installation

We will be resuming work in the area in early 2019 to complete works. You will be notified prior to the work taking place.

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, saw cutter, compactor, hand tools, drill rigs, trucks, lighting tower and construction vehicles to complete the works.
