



Night work is required for the Permanent Variable Message Sign on Princes Highway at Cooks River, Tempe

Night work for the permanent Variable Message Sign (VMS) is scheduled for Tuesday 22 January from 8pm to 5am Wednesday 23 January, with Wednesday night as a contingency date (weather permitting).

If we are unable to complete the work on the above dates, work will resume the following week on Wednesday 30 January to Friday 1 February 2019 to finalise installation of the VMS structure.

The location of the VMS has been selected to:

- minimise impact to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents, unplanned traffic incidents, bad weather, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journeys.

What we're doing

Construction will include:

- Installation of the VMS pole and outreach
- VMS sign installation
- Reinstatement of footpath

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, saw cutter, compactor, hand tools, elevated work platforms, trucks, lighting tower and construction vehicles to complete the works.

In the coming months we will return to complete the electrical installation in preparation for the VMS to be fully operational.
