



## Removal of the container wall at the Arncliffe compound on Marsh Street Arncliffe.

Work to remove the container wall from the Arncliffe compound is scheduled to take place from Monday 4 to Wednesday 6 February 2019 (weather permitting).

These works will be undertaken on Monday 4, Tuesday 5 and Wednesday 6 February from 10pm to 7am..

### What we're doing

To remove the container wall from the Arncliffe compound on Marsh Street Arncliffe, lane closures and pedestrian detours will be in place.

Two westbound lanes on the southern side of Marsh Street will be closed under traffic control from Airport Drive at the Cooks River to the M5 East turn off on Marsh Street. A pedestrian detour will also be in place under traffic control during these works. Please see the map overleaf for further clarification.

Equipment used to complete the works will include a crane, elevated work platform, prime movers, trucks and construction vehicles.

### How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise monitoring will be conducted for this work.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through the changed traffic conditions.
