



Night work on Campbell Street and Princes Highway, St Peters

Night work will take place in various locations near the intersection of Campbell Street and Princes Highway to carry out utility service installation and commissioning work. The map overleaf shows the location of these works.

1) Night work on Campbell Street (west)

Night work will be undertaken to install a new water main in the northern footpath on Campbell Street (west) along the temporary business access road. This work will take place at night to maintain business access during day-time opening hours. The work schedule is:

- **Monday 11 February from 7pm to 6am**
- **Tuesday 12 February from 7pm to 6am**
- **Wednesday 13 February from 7pm to 6am**

A road closure will be in place on the temporary business access road along the northern side of Campbell Street only. This work will not impact traffic on Campbell Street. Pedestrian access on the northern side of Campbell Street will be maintained under the direction of traffic control.

2) Night work on Campbell Street (east)

We are commissioning a newly installed water main on the northern side of Campbell Street (east) between Crown Street and Barwon Park Road on **Wednesday 13 February from 7pm to 6am**. This work will involve excavating the road pavement, cutting the existing Sydney Water assets and connecting it to the newly installed water main.

Some properties in the area may be impacted by a Sydney Water night time service outage in connection with this work on Wednesday 13 February between 10pm and 3am. Sydney Water will notify affected customers.

Vehicle and pedestrian access on Campbell Street (east) will not be impacted by this work.

3) Night work on Princes Highway

Night work will take place to install underground power and communications conduits in two locations along Princes Highway near the intersection of Campbell Street. Due to safety and traffic, this work must take place at night outside of peak traffic volume times.

Night work on Princes Highway north of Campbell Street:

- **Monday 11 February from 7pm to 6am**

Night work on Princes Highway south of Campbell Street:

- **Wednesday 13 February from 7pm to 6am**

Lane closures will be in place on Princes Highway near the intersection of Campbell Street and two-way traffic will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access on Princes Highway will be maintained under the direction of traffic control. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be directed to cross the road to the opposite footpath.

Parking restrictions will be in place along Princes Highway prior to each night work shift.

How this affects you

Equipment used during these works will include excavators, vacuum trucks, road saw, lighting towers, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, compaction equipment and traffic control.

Night work on Campbell Street (west) is expected to generate some noise; night work on Campbell Street (east) and Princes Highway is expected to generate some high noise in connection with excavation and commissioning work. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise and light generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

The site compounds on May Street and along the southern side of Campbell Street will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage of materials and vehicle parking.
