



Night and weekend work at the intersection of Sydney Park Road, Euston Road and Huntley Street Alexandria

We will build new road pavement as part of the upgrade to the Sydney Park Road, Euston Road and Huntley Street intersection. This work will be done at night and weekends when traffic volumes are lower for the safety of road users and workers.

What we're doing

We will relocate and install concrete barriers, mill the existing road pavement and place new pavement and asphalt on the road surface. The map overleaf shows the location of the works and related traffic changes. Construction works are scheduled at the following times:

Weekend one:

- **9pm on Friday 15 February to 5am on Monday 18 February**

Weekend two:

- **9pm on Friday 22 February to 5am on Monday 25 February**

Traffic changes

The traffic lights at the intersection of Sydney Park Road, Euston Road and Huntley Street Alexandria will be disabled from **9pm on Friday 15 February until 5am on Monday 18 February** and from **9pm on Friday 22 February until 5am on Monday 25 February**. A stop/slow traffic control set up will be in place during these times to manage all traffic movements through the intersection. Delays are expected, so allow extra travel time and use alternative routes where possible.

The following traffic changes will also be in place during these works:

- Sydney Park Road will reduce to one lane at the intersection. Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times under traffic control.
- Euston Road, north of the Sydney Park Road intersection, will be reduced to one lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times under traffic control.
- Huntley Street westbound will be closed to traffic between Burrows Road and Euston Road.
- Westbound traffic on Huntley Street will detour to Princes Highway via Burrows Road and Campbell Road.

When driving through the area, please take care and follow the direction of traffic control personnel and signage.

How this affects you

We will use an excavator, concrete saw cutter, roller, plate compactor, asphalt paver, line marking machine, crane, vacuum trucks, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, lighting towers and generators to complete the works. Work will include asphalt milling. Asphalt milling will create heat and may have an associated odour. This asphalt milling method is the standard construction process for removing asphalt. All New M5 Project Safety and Environmental regulations will be adhered to during this work. A water truck will be onsite to help mitigate dust.

The site compounds on Euston Road and May Street, St Peters will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage and vehicle parking.

This work will be noisy. We will minimise noise and light spill by scheduling noisy work during the day (where possible), install noise blankets around the work areas, turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use, use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery and directing noise generating equipment and turn lights away from residents' properties where possible.
