



## Day work at Elouera Street (north) Beverly Hills

Work to install a gantry over the M5 East motorway will be undertaken at the southern end of Elouera Street (north), 7am-6pm from 25 March to 31 May 2019 (weather permitting).

### What we're doing

Site establishment will take place on 25 March and remain in place until 31 May 2019. The compound will be located at the end of Elouera Street Beverly Hills adjacent to the M5 East, at the shared pedestrian pathway; we may be required to redirect pedestrian traffic on the shared pathway during some of these works. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

An exclusion zone will be set-up to ensure pedestrian safety around the work area. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians through the temporarily changed shared path.

The shared pedestrian path will be reopened at the end of each work day.

Equipment used on site will include:

- Vacuum truck
- Generator
- Concrete cutter
- Drill machine
- Road sweeper
- Water cart
- Hand tools
- Electrical tools
- Construction vehicles

Some of this work will be noisy and noise modelling has been conducted for this work. We appreciate your patience as we complete these works.
