



## Night work, weekend work and traffic changes on Euston Road, Alexandria

New Ausgrid power conduits will be installed on Euston Road between Maddox Street and Sydney Park Road. Service investigation and installation work is required to be undertaken at night and during the weekend when traffic volumes are lower for the safety of pedestrians, workers and motorists. The work schedule is weather permitting.

### What we're doing

This work will include excavating the current road pavement on Euston Road; installing new power conduits and reinstating the road surface. Work will be undertaken during the following shifts:

- Monday 1 April, 8pm to 6am
- Friday 5 April, 10am to 6am
- Saturday 6 April, 8am to 6pm
- Sunday 7 April, 8am to 6pm

### Traffic changes

The following traffic changes will be in place on Monday 1 April from 8pm to 6am, and from 10am Friday 5 April to 6pm Sunday 7 April:

- Traffic lights at the Euston Road and Maddox Street intersection will flash amber during this work. Traffic controllers will direct motorists through the intersection. Please follow the direction of traffic control personnel.
- The left turn onto Euston Road from Sydney Park Road (for motorists travelling eastbound) will be unavailable during work.
- The left turn onto Euston Road from Maddox street (for motorists travelling westbound) will be unavailable during work.
- One of two westbound lanes on Maddox Street (between Bourke Road and Euston Road) will be closed. However, westbound traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access around the intersection of Maddox Street and Euston Road will be maintained throughout this work.

Please expect delays in the area, take extra caution, and follow the direction of traffic signs and traffic control on duty when travelling through this area.

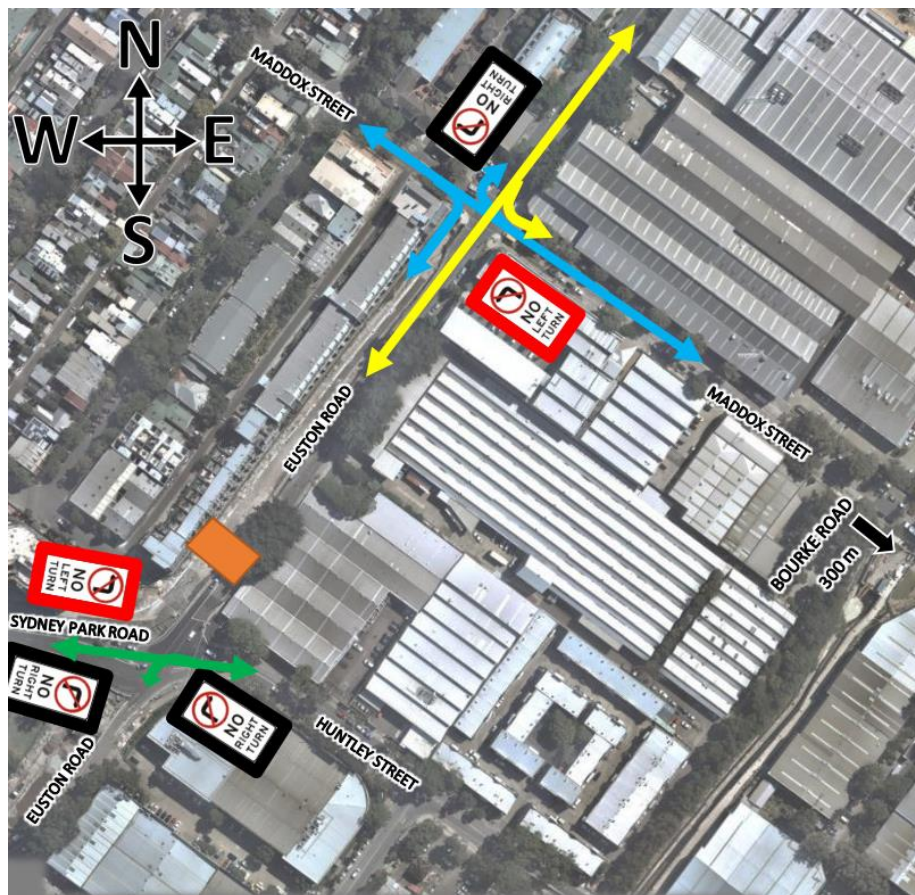
## How this affects you

Equipment used during the night work will include lighting towers, concrete saw, excavator and hammer, tipper truck, bogie truck, vacuum truck, rattle gun, asphalt roller and traffic management and construction vehicles. The work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may have higher noise impacts to take place early in the night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, and directing noise generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible.







Please also be advised that night work on Euston Road and Maddox Street (originally scheduled from Tuesday 26 March to Wednesday 3 April and detailed in community notification N.651) has been postponed. Residents and businesses will be advised of revised dates of work when this has been confirmed.

-  Work area – Night work: Mon 1 Apr, Fri 5 Apr | Day work: Sat 6 Apr, Sun 7 Apr
-  Traffic travelling west and east on Sydney Park Road and Huntley Street maintained under traffic control (left turn from Huntley Street to Euston Road southbound permitted)
-  Traffic travelling north and south on Euston Road maintained under the direction of traffic control
-  Traffic travelling west and east on Maddox Street maintained under the direction of traffic control (right turn from Maddox Street east of Euston Road, and right turn from Maddox Street west of Euston Road permitted)
-  No left turn during work
-  No left/right turn at any time
