



Nightwork at M5 East, Arncliffe

Night work is required during the M5 East shutdown at the on and off ramps at Princes Highway and Marsh Street to progress construction of the New M5.

What we're doing

Activities for the April shutdown/s will include:

- Gantry work including footing excavation and concrete work at Marsh St
- Gantry delivery and installation
- Gantry electrical work and alignment
- Installation of temporary signage
- Removal of noise wall panels
- Tree removal at Princes Highway and Marsh Street
- Service investigation
- Edge protect and footpath construction
- Road sweeping
- Demolition of concrete barrier

This work will be carried out during the existing M5 East maintenance shutdown period (weather permitting) and will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists.

Equipment used will include excavators with rock breaker, hydro blaster, concrete cutters, truck mounted coring machine, cranes, elevated work platforms, vacuum trucks, road sweepers, concrete agitators, concrete pumps, lighting towers, electric hand tools, chainsaws, and compressors as well as other construction vehicles.

How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy, however noise monitoring will be conducted for all activities during these works. Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through these changed traffic conditions.
