



## Night work on Euston Road and Maddox Street, Alexandria

Existing Ausgrid power conduits will be investigated and new Ausgrid power conduits installed in four locations on Euston Road and Maddox Street. This work is required to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are lower for the safety of pedestrians, workers and motorists. The work schedule is weather permitting.

### What we're doing

We will excavate the existing road surface, install new power conduits and reinstate the road surface.

Work will occur in four work areas (please see map overleaf):

Work areas 1 and 2:

- Monday 8 April, 8pm to 5am

Work areas 2 and 3:

- Wednesday 10 April, 8pm to 5am
- Friday 12 April, 8pm to 5am
- Monday 15 April, 8pm to 5am
- Wednesday 17 April, 8pm to 5am

### Traffic changes

The following traffic conditions will apply during this work:

- Traffic lights at the Maddox Street and Euston Road intersection will flash amber during this work. Traffic control will direct motorists through the intersection. Please follow the direction of traffic control personnel.
- No left turn onto Euston Road from Maddox Street
- One westbound lane along Maddox street will be closed, however, westbound traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access around the intersection of Maddox Street and Euston Road will be maintained throughout this work under the direction of traffic control personnel.

Please expect delays in the area, drive carefully and follow the direction of traffic signs and traffic control personnel on duty when travelling through this area.

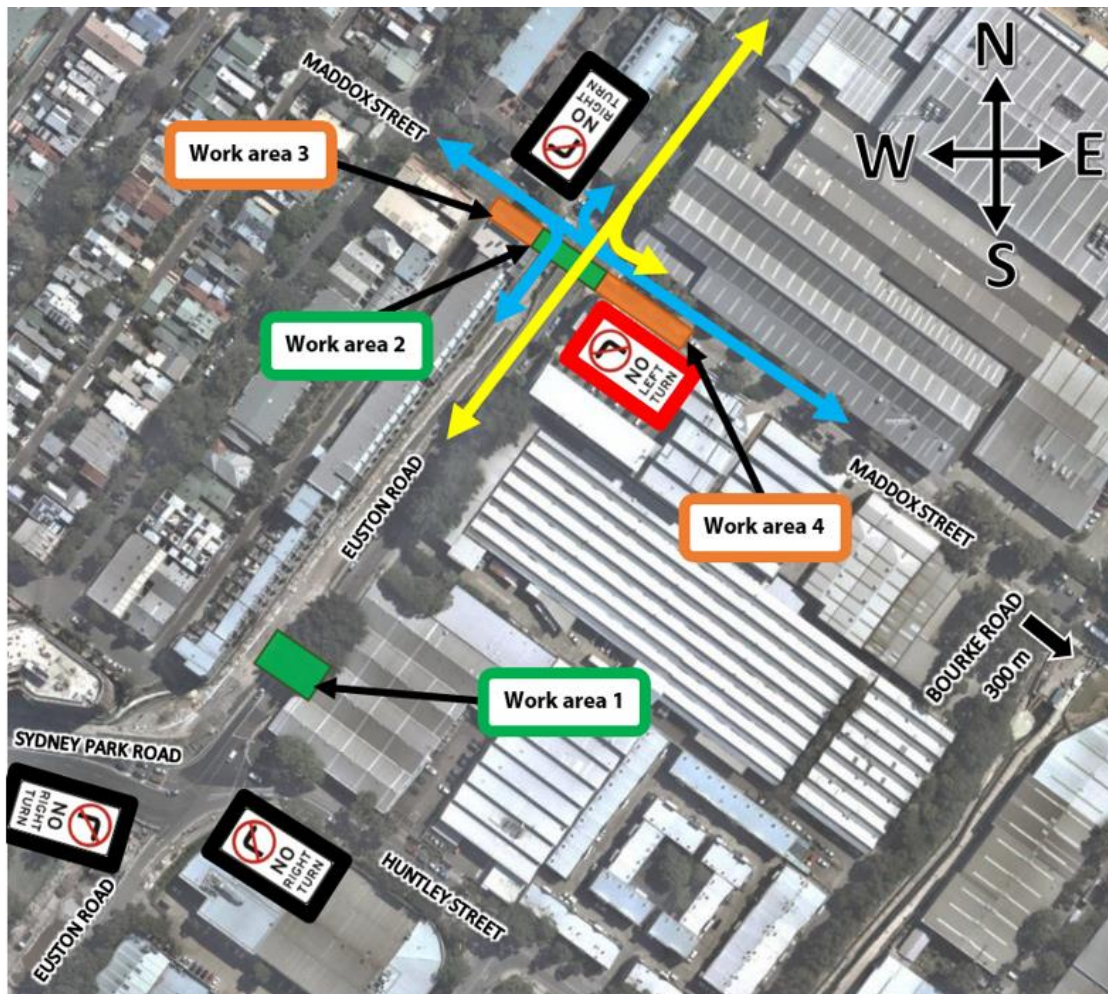








## How this affects you

Equipment used during the night work will include lighting towers, concrete saw, excavator, asphalt roller, traffic management and construction vehicles. The work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may have higher noise impacts to take place early in the night, where possible. Every effort will be made to turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use, and use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery. We will direct noise generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible.
