



Night work in Kingsgrove & Bexley North

A reminder that night work will be undertaken in sections of the road verge, on the M5 East between Bexley Road and King Georges Road to progress construction of the New M5.

Moving forward Ventia Boral have made changes to their maintenance calendar by splitting the regular four consecutive nights of work over a number of separate dates or adding additional dates to their calendar.

What we're doing

Work will be carried out over four nights during the existing M5 East maintenance shutdown periods (weather permitting). These works will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Activities for the May shutdown will include:

- Barrier installation and relocation
- Storm water earthworks
- Road lighting works including slipform, concreting, excavation and reo fixing
- Gantry work including footing excavation, concrete work, installation of cladding, conduit installation and backfilling, alignment and cable works
- Gantry delivery and installation including work on the shared user path at Bexley North
- Concrete saw cutting
- Gantry electrical installation and alignment
- North and south tunnel portal works including excavation work, piling, concreting and shotcreting
- Milling, resurfacing and asphaltting on the road surface
- Service investigation
- Concrete pavement and footpath construction
- Signage removal and installation of new signage

- CCTV inspection of stormwater drain
- Road sweeping
- Removal of construction material from the median
- Trenching and conduit installation

Equipment used will include excavators, concrete saws, cranes, elevated work platforms, vacuum trucks, road sweepers, concrete agitators, lighting towers, electric hand tools, impact wench, chainsaws, excavators with hammers, generators, barrier installation machine and compressors as well as other construction vehicles.

How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy, however noise monitoring will be conducted during these works. Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through these changes.
