



Nightwork at M5 East in Arncliffe

Night work is required during the M5 East shutdown at the on and off ramps at Princes Highway and Marsh Street, Arncliffe.

This work is part of the New M5 project which will double the capacity of the existing M5 tunnel and the M5 East corridor.

What we're doing

Tree removal at the M5 East on and off ramps and preparation work for the gantry installation.

This work will be carried out over four nights during the existing M5 East maintenance shutdown period from Sunday 9 December to Wednesday 12 December 2018 (weather permitting). These works will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists.

How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise monitoring will be conducted for activities undertaken outside of standard construction hours. Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through these changed traffic conditions.

Equipment used will include excavators, concrete cutters, truck mounted coring machine, cranes, trucks, elevated work platforms, vacuum trucks, road sweepers, concrete agitators, lighting towers, electric hand tools, wood chipper and compressors as well as other construction vehicles.
