



## Night work on Sydney Park Road, Alexandria

Night work is scheduled for the installation of Intelligent Transport Services (ITS) infrastructure on Sydney Park Road.

### What we're doing

New ITS infrastructure will support new Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) to be installed on Sydney Park Road. This system will monitor traffic and provide updated traffic information to local Variable Messaging Signs (VMS), also to be installed.

Night work will be carried out in two work areas on Sydney Park Road to remove existing ITS services and install new conduits below the road surface. Please note: work will begin at the outer edges of work areas and will move inward towards the middle of Sydney Park Road. Please see the map overleaf for more details.

Work will include the excavation of the current footpath and removal of existing services, installation of new ITS conduits and reinstating the footpath by 5am each morning. This work will be undertaken during the following shifts.

### King Street work area:

- Wednesday 15 May, 8pm to 5am
- Friday 17 May, 8pm to 5am

### Mitchell Road work area:

- Tuesday 14 May, 8pm to 5am
- Thursday 16 May, 8pm to 5am

### Traffic changes

Traffic on Sydney Park Road at the intersection will be maintained in both directions under the direction of traffic control personnel. Please drive carefully and follow the direction of traffic control personnel and traffic signage when travelling in this area. Pedestrian traffic on Sydney Park Road will be maintained under traffic control.

Equipment used during the night work will include lighting towers, concrete saw, excavator, rock breaker, jack hammer, construction trucks, road saw, vacuum truck, traffic management and construction vehicles.

Excavation work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may generate high noise to take place early in the night where possible. Every effort will be made to turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use and use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery. We will direct noise generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible.
