



Changes to pedestrian access at the May Street intersection and westbound lane closure on Campbell Street St Peters

From **Wednesday 15 May**, a section of footpath on May Street will be closed to allow for construction work to progress and remain closed for approximately 8 weeks. Pedestrian access will be facilitated via a temporary footpath.

On **Friday 17 May**, a westbound lane closure on Campbell Street (west) will be in place to prepare for landscaping work.

1) Changes to pedestrian access at the May Street intersection

Day work will continue on the corner of May Street and Campbell Street, and along the eastern side of May Street approximately 80 meters from the Campbell Street intersection towards Daburi Lane. This includes drainage investigation and installation work, kerb, gutter and footpath reconstruction, and road pavement construction.

A section of footpath on the eastern side of May Street, near the Campbell Street intersection, will be closed from **Wednesday 15 May for approximately 8 weeks** to establish a fenced construction work area in this location. Pedestrian access will be maintained via a temporary pedestrian footpath which will also connect to Hutchinson Street as shown on the map overleaf.

2) Westbound lane closure on Campbell Street (west)

Landscaping preparation work will take place on the southern side of Campbell Street (west) between St Peters Street and Princes Highway. This will involve placing planting mix and mulch along the southern verge. The work schedule is:

- **Friday 17 May from 9am to 3pm**
- **Monday 20 May and Tuesday 21 May from 9am to 3pm** - (contingency)

- Eastbound only traffic between Church Street and Princes Highway.

- Local access into Campbell Street from Princes Highway northbound. No access to Campbell Street (west) from Campbell Street (east).
- For access to St Peters Street, Hutchinson Street, Lackey Street and Applebee Street (residents only) a left turn will be permitted from Church Street to Campbell Street, via Victoria Street.
- Pedestrian access on Campbell Street (west) will be maintained.

Traffic control personnel and signage will be in place, please expect delays when travelling in this area.

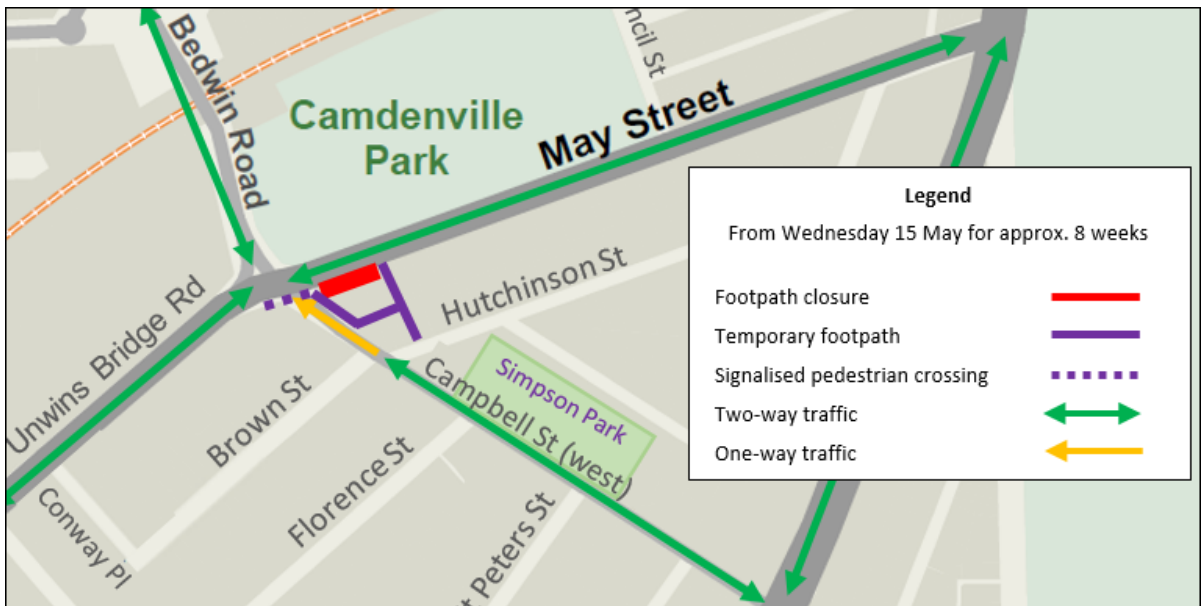
How this affects you

Day work on May Street is expected to generate intrusive noise in connection with excavation of the existing road pavement. Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with these works by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.
