



## Utility work and traffic changes on Campbell Street (west), Church Street, Hutchinson Street and the May Street intersection

Day work will take place along Campbell Street (west), Church Street, Hutchinson Street and the May Street intersection to carry out utility work. This work will involve traffic changes, including a road closure on Church Street.

### 1) Campbell Street (west) and Church Street

#### • Saturday 23 March from 8am to 6pm

Day work will be undertaken to inspect the newly installed water main in the northern footpath on Campbell Street (west) between Simpson Park and Princes Highway. This work will take place on the weekend to minimise the impact on local businesses. A road closure will be in place on the temporary business access road along the northern side of Campbell Street only. This work will not impact traffic on Campbell Street (west).

#### • Tuesday 26 March and Wednesday 27 March from 7am to 6pm

Day work will take place to commission the new underground electrical network and remove existing overhead power cables along Campbell Street (west) between St Peters Street and Princes Highway and on Church Street. Some properties in the area may be impacted by a day-time Ausgrid service outage in connection with this work on Wednesday 27 March between 7am and 5pm. Ausgrid will notify affected customers.

### Traffic changes on Tuesday 26 March and Wednesday 27 March from 7am to 6pm

- Road closure on Church street at the Campbell Street intersection. Access to Church Street will be maintained via Victoria Street
- Parking restrictions will be in place along the eastern side of Church Street from 7am Tuesday 26 March to 6pm Wednesday 27 March
- Stop/slow traffic set up on Campbell Street (west) between St Peters Street and Princes Highway. Two-way traffic will be maintained however please expect delays and follow the direction of traffic control
- Footpath closure on the southern side of Campbell Street between St Peters Street and Church Street. Please note, this footpath closure will be in place overnight from 7am Tuesday 26 March to 6pm Wednesday 27 March. Traffic control will be in place for the duration of the footpath closure to assist pedestrians through the changed traffic conditions.

## 2) Hutchinson Street and May Street intersection

Weekend work will take place on **Sunday 24 March from 8am to 6pm** to decommission overhead Ausgrid power cables on Hutchinson Street near the Campbell Street intersection and in various locations at the May Street intersection.

### Traffic changes on Sunday 24 March from 8am to 6pm

- All existing turning movements at the May Street, Campbell Street, Unwins Bridge Road and Bedwin Road intersection will be maintained, however please expect delays and follow the direction of traffic control signage and personnel
- Access into Hutchinson Street from Campbell Street will be maintained under the direction of traffic control
- Parking restrictions will be in place along May Street from 7am Saturday 23 March to 6pm Sunday 24 March

### How this affects you

Pedestrian access around all work areas will be maintained under the direction of traffic control. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be directed to cross the road to the opposite footpath. At times during this work, pedestrians will be detoured away from the work area on Campbell Street between Church Street and St Peters Street when the footpath in the area has been excavated.

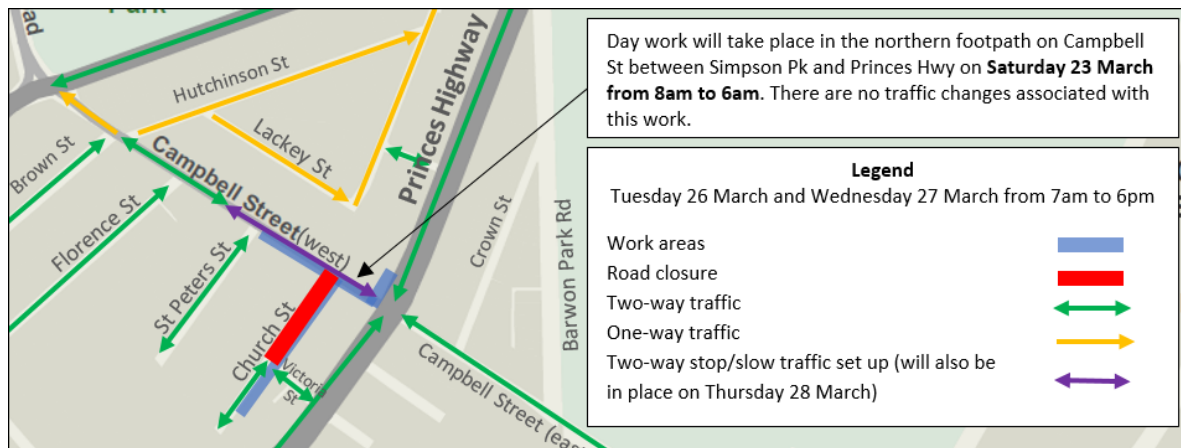
Equipment used during this work will include a road saw, rock breaker, excavator, vacuum truck, elevated work platform, mobile crane, construction vehicles, compaction equipment, hand tools and traffic control. This work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with these works by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible. The site compounds on May Street and along Campbell Street will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage of materials and vehicle parking.
