



## Overhead power cable work on Church Avenue, Mascot

In order to widen Bourke Street, work is taking place to relocate existing services such as water, electricity and communications within the new road alignment. This includes moving the existing overhead power cables, and placing them underground. This work is being undertaken in conjunction with a planned power outage which residents will be notified for separately, by Ausgrid.

### What we're doing

So far the crews have installed and connected new underground power cables across Bourke Street at the intersection with Church Avenue. Now the crews are required to disconnect the remaining overhead cables before the poles are removed at a later date.

This work will include:

- Using a small crane to access the overhead cables
- Having an electrician disconnect the cables from the overhead poles and make adjustments in the adjacent service pit
- Reinstatement of any excavated ground

Equipment will include a hiab crane (small crane), vacuum truck, small excavator, bucket truck, hand tools, and light vehicles

### Traffic changes

There will be minor traffic changes in place during the work which will include **temporary removal of the parking lane closest to either work location.**

Reduced speed limits, traffic personnel and signage will be in place to guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists through the changes.

- Keeping conversations between workers and traffic control quiet

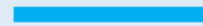

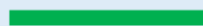
Temporary removal of traffic lane
