

Traffic changes, night work and weekend work on the Princes Highway and Campbell Street, St Peters

Weekday night work and weekend day work will be carried out for the installation and relocation of utilities including communications, power, gas and water on Princes Highway.

Timing of work

Work will take place on Princes Highway around the intersection of Campbell Street for up to **4 night shifts** between **Monday 4 November** and **Monday 11 December**.

Concrete barriers will be removed from the site compound on Church Street and relocated to the Princes Highway intersection during night shift on **Friday 8 December**. The intersection of Princes Highway and Campbell Street west will be closed to through traffic while the concrete barriers are in place. The concrete barriers will be relocated back to the Church Street site compound on **Sunday 10 December** following the weekend intersection closure.

- Night work will be carried out from **7pm to 5am** on the following days:
 - **Monday 4 December**
 - **Wednesday 6 December** (*as contingency*)
 - **Friday 8 December**
 - **Monday 11 December**
- Weekend day work will take place from **8am to 6pm** on **Saturday 9 December** and **Sunday 10 December**.

Traffic changes

- Traffic control will be in place on Princes Highway between Victoria Street and Short Street around the work area during **weekday night shifts** from **7pm to 5am**. Traffic on Princes Highway in both directions will be maintained
- The intersection of Campbell Street west and Princes Highway will be closed to through traffic from **7pm on Friday 8 December** to **6pm on Sunday 10 December**.
During the intersection closure traffic control will be in place at the May Street and Campbell Street intersection. Local access to Campbell Street will be maintained for vehicles travelling from May Street southbound.

Work activities

This utility work will take place at night and over the weekend to reduce traffic disruption during peak traffic periods. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users, pedestrians and cyclists through the changes.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with night work by:

- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible

Equipment used during this work will include an excavator, concrete saw, plate compactor, mobile crane, lighting towers, vacuum truck, traffic control, hand tools construction trucks and light vehicles.

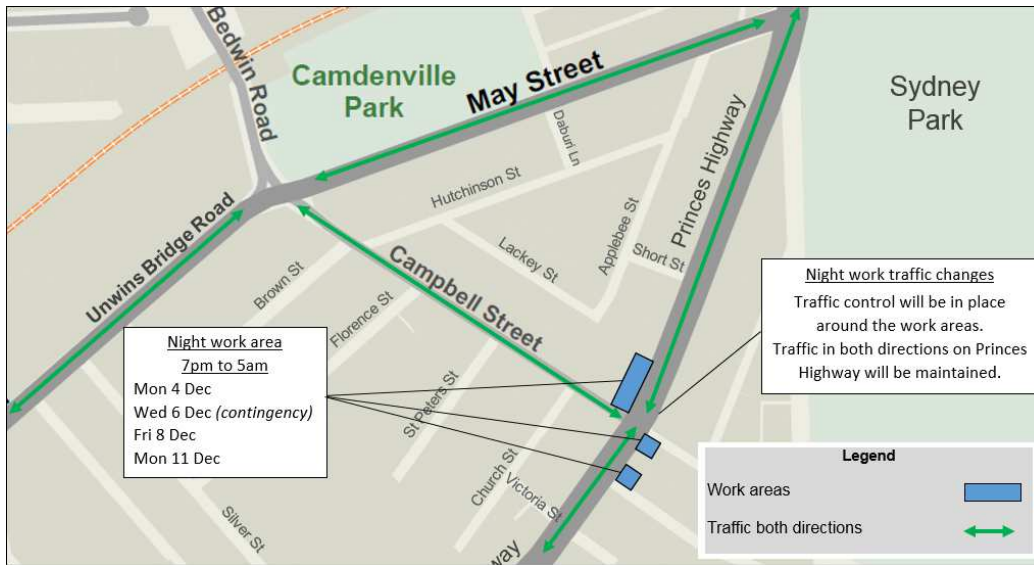
