



## Update to notification no.367 (12 March)

### Weekend work, road closures and traffic changes on Campbell Street (west), St Peters

As advised in the community notification distributed to properties on 12 March, work is ongoing to install and upgrade utilities along Campbell Street and surrounding intersections. Weekend work will take place on Campbell Street, near the intersection of Brown Street and Hutchinson Street, from **7am Friday 16 March to 5am Monday 19 March (inclusive)**. If the work is completed on Sunday 18 March, the road will be reopened to traffic and traffic changes removed. In addition to the previous changes, the below traffic change will be in place.

**No access into Campbell Street (west) from Campbell St (east) – this is to prevent heavy vehicle traffic attempting to use Florence St.**

This work will be conducted over the weekend when traffic volumes are lower for the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Pedestrians will be managed through the work areas where possible. Pedestrians will be unable to access across the trenched road excavation on Campbell Street between Brown Street and May Street. Pedestrians detour via Brown Street and Conway Place to Unwins Bridge Road or Hutchinson Street and Daburi Lane to May Street.

#### What we're doing

New drainage pipes and utilities will be installed across Campbell Street near the intersection of Brown Street and Hutchinson Street.

#### Traffic changes

- Campbell Street (west) will be closed in both directions between the Bedwin Road, May Street and Unwins Bridge Road intersection and Florence Street
- Full closure of the Campbell Street (west), Brown Street and Hutchinson Street intersection - no through traffic
- No access from Brown Street to Campbell Street (west)
- Brown Street residents access via Unwins Bridge Road & Conway Place only
- No access from Hutchinson Street to Campbell Street (west)
- Hutchinson Street and Daburi Lane residents access via May Street and Applebee Street or via Princes Highway, Short Street and Applebee Street
- Lackey Street residents access via May Street, Appleby Street and Hutchinson Street
- **Hutchinson Street between Applebee Street and Lackey Street will be reversed to one-way southbound traffic only**
- Hutchinson Street between Campbell Street and Lackey Street will be two-way traffic
- Applebee Street between May Street and Hutchinson Street will be two-way traffic

- Stop/ slow traffic set up will be in place on Campbell Street (west) between Florence Street and Church Street at times during the weekend work
- **Eastbound traffic only on Campbell Street (west) from Church Street to Princes Highway. No access from Campbell Street (east) into Campbell Street (west).**

Temporary parking restrictions will be in place on Brown Street, Hutchinson Street and surrounding streets ahead of the implementation of the road closure from **7am Thursday 15 March for the duration of the works**. Traffic control will be in place around the work areas and on surrounding streets to manage road users through the temporary weekend changes.

Equipment used during the work will include excavators, compactors, rollers, road saw, jackhammer, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, lighting towers, and mobile cranes.

The site compound on May Street and along the southern side of Campbell Street (west) will be used intermittently throughout the weekend work for storage and tipping of materials and vehicle parking. The work is expected to create some noise impacts to nearby residents.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery during night work
- directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible
