



Closure of Footpath at Tempe Reserve

A closure of the Tempe Reserve footpath, running parallel to the wetlands is required to facilitate repair work on the footpath for one week commencing from Monday 18 June to Monday 25 June 2018 (see map overleaf).

What we're doing

This work will involve saw cutting and excavation of the existing footpath, removal of the rubble and a concrete truck delivering concrete to reinstate the footpath. The footpath will be closed off for the duration of this work and reopened once work is completed.

Work hours:

- Monday to Friday - 7am to 6pm
- Saturday 8am to 1pm

Equipment used saw cutter, hydraulic hammer, small excavator, tipper truck, concrete truck.

How this affects you

A closure will be in place along the footpath, signage will be in place advising cyclists and pedestrians of this closure and a detour route will be in place.
