Traffic impacts from weekend works on Euston Road, Alexandria

Further to the notification distributed on 1 June regarding multiple weekends of continuous work to install a new electrical cable along Euston Road, work will be undertaken this weekend at the Sydney Park roundabout and Maddox Street/ Euston Road intersection.

The team are required to install a new 132kV electrical cable under the western side of Sydney Park roundabout and across the Maddox Street intersection including excavation of a trench, identifying services, laying conduits and backfilling. Work to install new utilities is also being conducted on Campbell Street and Campbell Road over the weekend.

Work has been scheduled across multiple locations on the same weekend to reduce the overall impact on the community and motorists. The work is expected to cause local traffic impacts and **motorists are encouraged to take alternative routes** over the weekend.

Timing of work

Work will be undertaken between **7pm on Friday 4 August and 5am on Monday 7 August**. The work will be continuous and traffic impacts will be in place for the duration.

Traffic impacts

Sydney park roundabout:

- Sydney Park roundabout will be operating under a stop/ slow arrangement. This means that only one entrance into the roundabout will be utilised at a time. Traffic control personnel will be controlling the flow of traffic.
- There will be delays to buses who use the roundabout as part of their route. Please visit transportnsw.info for more information

Maddox Street:

- The road will be operating normally during day time hours, however from 7pm, (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) there will be a left turn only into Euston Road from Maddox Street. You cannot go straight or turn right into Euston Road.

Campbell Street (in place **8am to 10pm Saturday 5 August**, and **8am to 6pm on Sunday on 6 August**):

- Full road closure between May Street and Euston Road
- Eastbound traffic will be permitted between Euston Road and Burrows Road
- No westbound traffic movements along Campbell Street and Road. Resident access permitted.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. **We encourage local residents to plan their journey during this weekend to avoid delays, either leaving home with extra travel time or taking alternative routes to their destination.**

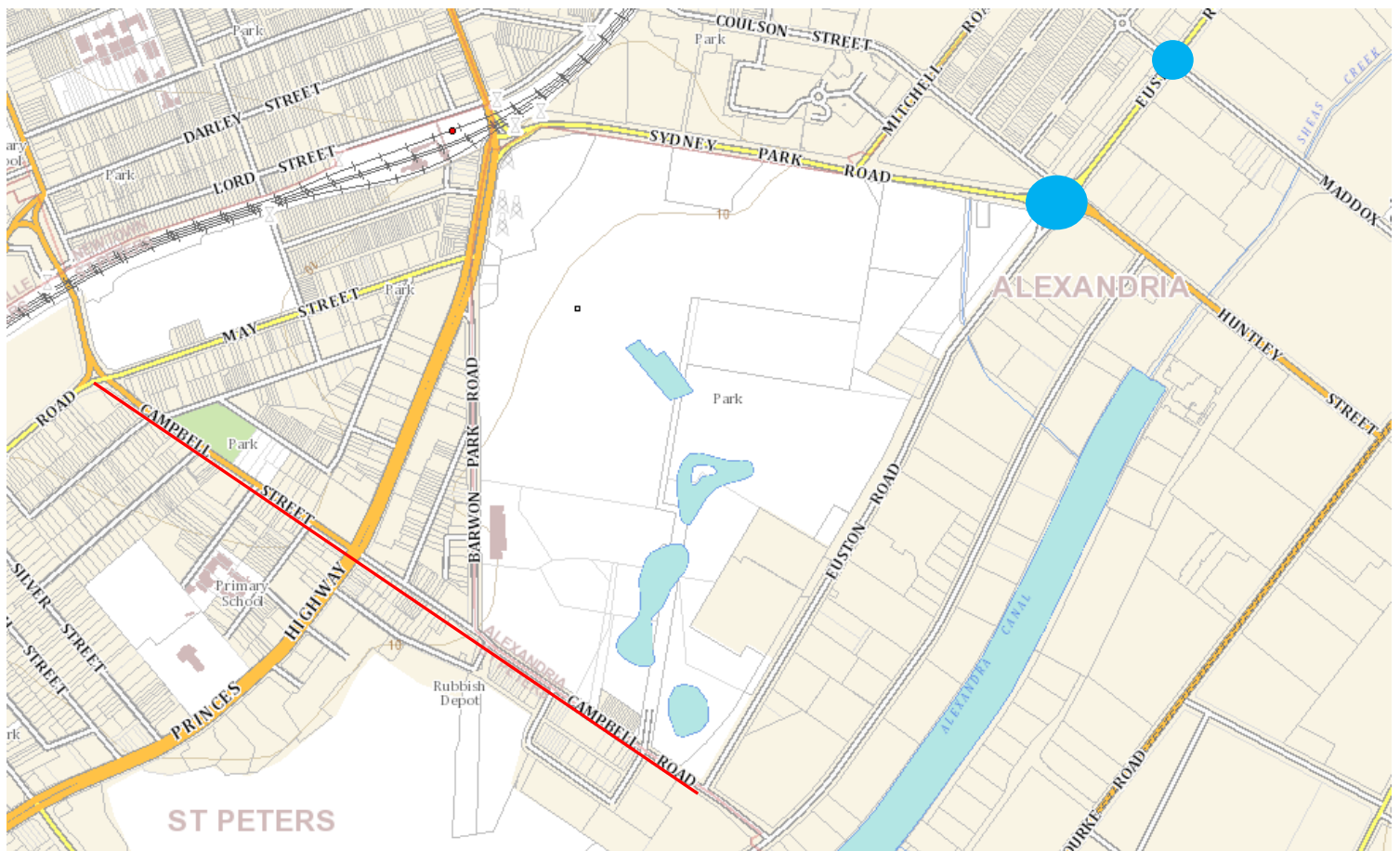
