

Night work on Euston Road, Alexandria

Night work is required to take place on Euston Road in order to undertake repair works to the 132kv Ausgrid electrical conduits. This work needs to occur at night under traffic management to limit impact on day-time traffic and for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Timing and scope of works

Work will be carried out on **Friday 1 December** weather permitting, and is expected to take **two nights** to complete with a second night (a contingency night if required) on Monday 4 December. Work will be conducted between the hours of **9pm and 5am**. Work will take place at three locations on Euston Road as shown on the map provided overleaf.

The work will involve opening a small trench in the ground, removing ground material, repairing the conduit and then reinstating the earth.

Equipment used during the work will include excavator, compactor, concrete saw, rock breaker, lighting tower, hand tools, potholing trucks, traffic management and construction vehicles.

Minimising impact on residents

This work is expected to be noisy and will likely be heard by nearby residents. As the work is not taking place over two consecutive nights, alternative accommodation will not be offered to residents during this work.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work including:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Installing noise barriers blankets around each location of night work to help contain the noise
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

Traffic changes

Changed traffic conditions will be in place for the duration of this work including:

- Stop/ slow traffic arrangement in place between Harley Street and Sydney Park roundabout
- Southbound street parking removed between Harley Street and Sydney Park Roundabout
- Motorists encouraged to take alternate route


Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes.

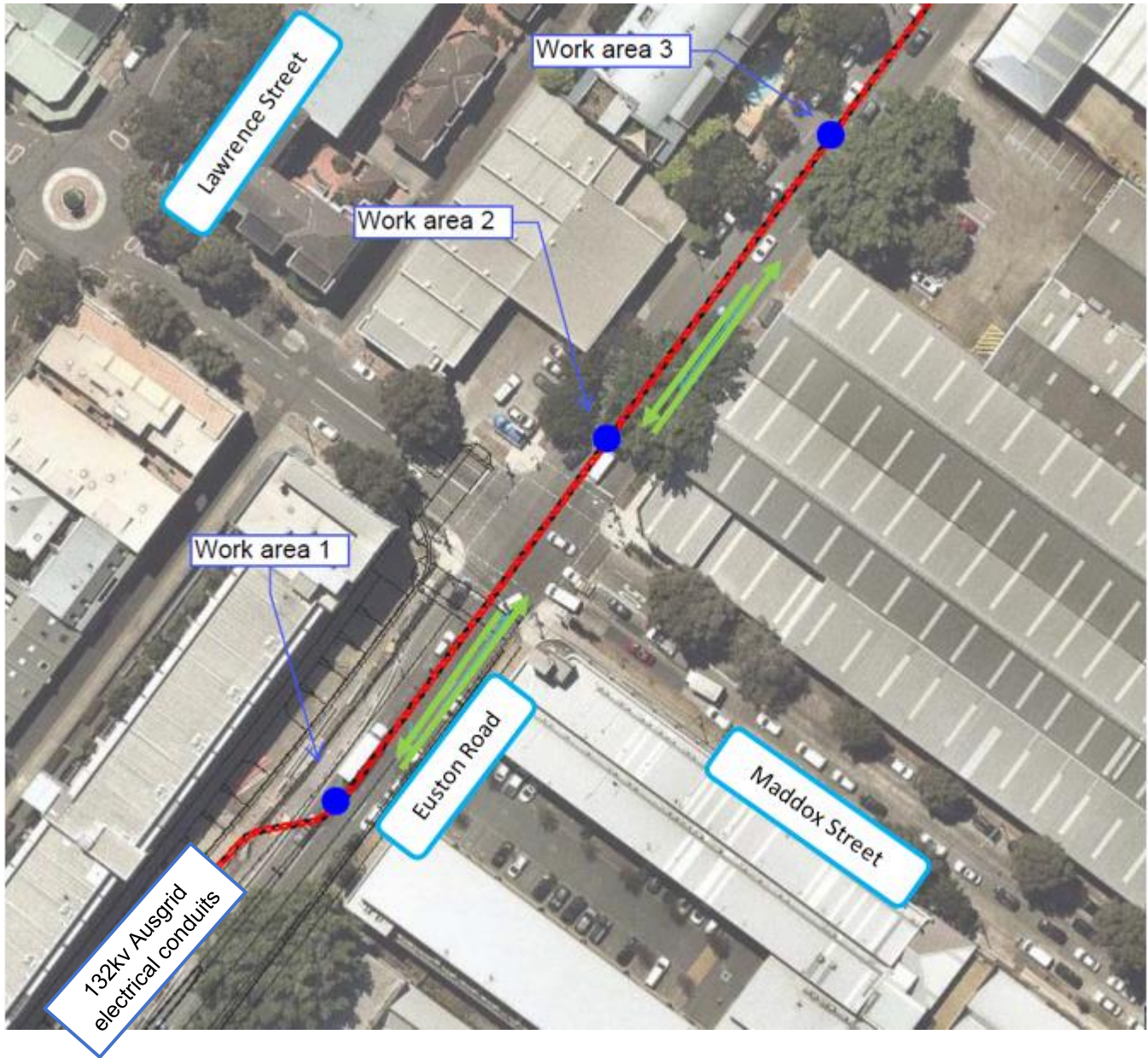
